
The Pro Vice Chancellor Chaired the meeting and welcomed all the members. Controller of examinations presented the results of the Autumn Semester End Examinations, 2018. He reported that the results of all the programmes have been prepared except the results of 3<sup>rd</sup> semester B.Ed and second semester PG Diploma in Paralegal Practice. The results of these two programmes could not be prepared due to continuation of internship beyond the semester end examination and inability to submit the grade by the concerned Departments. The committee expressed concern over the delay and asked the Department to be advised to take necessary corrective actions so that delays in results do not occur in future. CoE also informed that out of 3319 students who appeared the examinations, 2877 students cleared the examinations of all the courses offered to them i.e. they passed the semester end examinations without any backlog and over all pass percentage is 86.68%. **Detailed statement of the results is attached here with.**


The meeting expressed concerned for postponement of declaring the results from 31.12.2018 to 8.01.2019 which was mainly due to (i) break down of server towards the end of the semester and disrupting the course registration and later on grade entry (2) Engagement of staff of the Controller of Examinations in Gaon Panchayat election held on 5<sup>th</sup> December, 2018 and (3) Convocation held on 27.12.2018 etc.

After thorough discussions and examining the results carefully the meeting resolved the following:

1. The results of B.Ed and PG Diploma in Paralegal Practice be prepared by giving "X" grade ( i.e. extended project) on the internship course.
2. Minor corrections pointed out by the concerned Heads of the Departments may be corrected.
3. **After corrections, the results of all the programmes be declared** including BEd and PG Diploma in Paralegal Practice.
4. The staff of the CoE may be exempted from election duty in future. Registrar may be requested take up the matter with the District Administration.
5. A line of notice regretting delay in publishing the results may be uploaded on the website by the CoE.


Minutes of the Examination Committee meeting held on 14.06.2019 at 4.00 pm in the Board Room of VC's Office

The meeting examined the results of the Spring Semester End Examination, 2019, for the batches of students of final semester of various programmes. The statements of results were placed before the exam committee by the COE (copy enclosed).

- i. Out of 1150 nos. of students of outgoing batches, 1118 nos. of students cleared their semester end examination. As many as 14 nos. of students were put under Academic Probation, 05 students were given 'I' grade, 10 students were given 'X' grade and 3 students were given W grade ( i.e. courses withdrawn).
- ii. Overall 97.22% of students passed without any backlog and there is no significant change in pass percentage as compared to previous years.
- iii. The committee resolved to declare the results of the students after incorporating the minor corrections in the results.











