Museum</p>	<p>Name: Cultural Interpretation Centre, Dept. of Cultural Studies</p> <p>Year of Establishment: 2017</p> <p>The Cultural Interpretation Centre in the Department of Cultural Studies was established as a part of the activities of the UGC-sponsored Centre with Potential for Excellence in Particular Areas (CPEPA) which operated on the title of <i>Cultural Memory in North-East India: A Research and Documentation Programme on Textual and Visual Narratives</i>. It was created under the supervision of Prof. A. K. Das, former Tagore Fellow, IGNCA, New Delhi.
