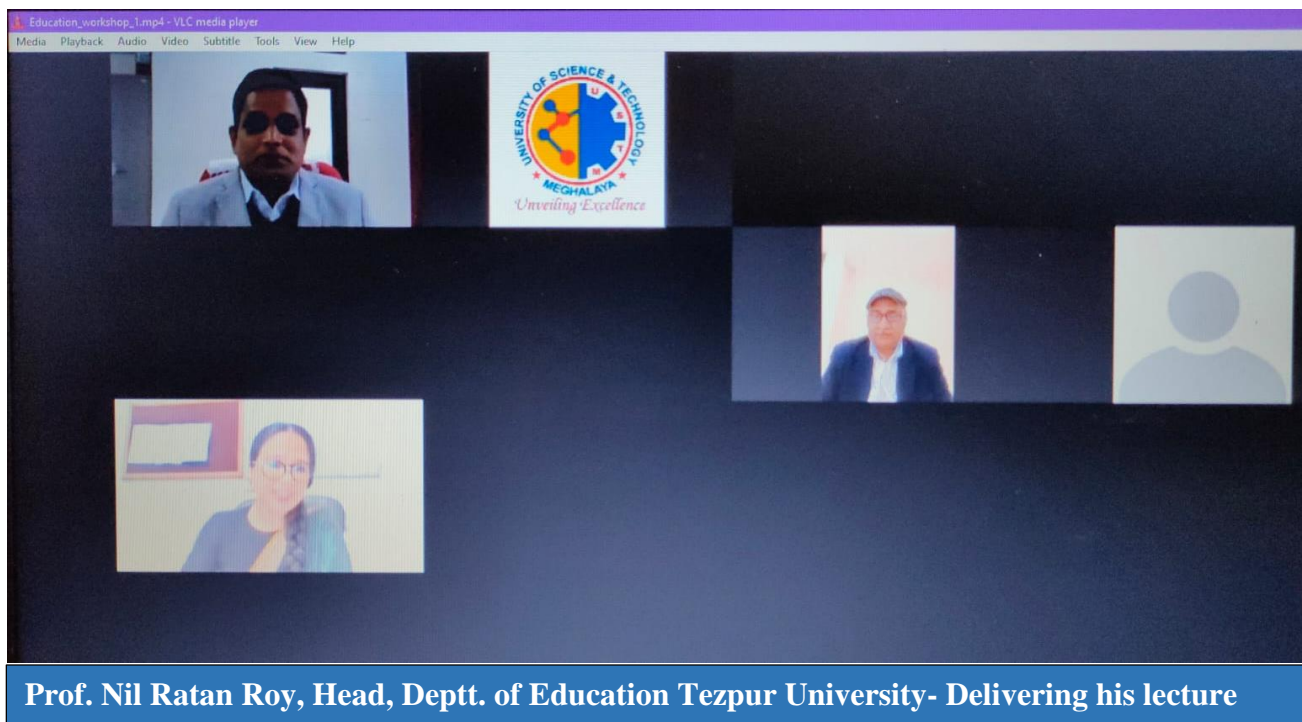
Dr. Rai delivered his lecture on “Technology Connectivity in Teaching and Learning.” He discussed on the following areas:
