## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

### **1. Duration and Full-time Nature of the grant**

- a. Duration of grant is specified in item 4 above.
- b. Full-time Nature of the Grant: This grant is made for the purpose of full-time study/training/research. Grantees are not permitted to accept remuneration from outside agencies.

### **2. Termination of the Grant**

- a. The J. William Fulbright Foreign Scholarships Board (FSB) and the Office of the Academic Program, Department of State, reserve the right to revoke or terminate this grant with concurrence of USIEF and to withhold return transportation to the home country should non-compliance with the provisions of the grant warrant such action. The host institution and the cooperating agency (IIE) may recommend revocation of a grant to the Department of State and the FSB.
- b. Grounds for revocation include, but are not limited to, the following: violation of the laws of the United States; misconduct; failure to maintain satisfactory scholastic standing; failure to carry out the professional purpose for which the grant was awarded; failure to complete the grant because of voluntary termination, including premature departure from institution of affiliation in the U.S.; engaging in political or unauthorized income producing activities; or other activities which in the discretion of the Board of Foreign Scholarships, the Department of State and USIEF are inconsistent with the purpose and best interests of the program; failure to submit the reports required by the supervising agency; physical or mental incapacitation. If the grant is revoked or terminated on any of the above mentioned grounds except physical or mental incapacitation, the grantee agrees to repay to USIEF the cost of transportation furnished.
- c. Grantees who remain in the U.S. after the expiration of the grant are subject to the provisions of this section in that may be deprived of return travel to their home country.

### **3. General:**

- a. Visa: The use of this grant is contingent upon availability of transportation and the grantee's ability to secure a passport and appropriate Exchange Visitor Visa (J) under program number G-I-1. Section 212 (e) of the Immigration and Naturalization Act, as amended, provides in part that no person admitted to the U.S. as an Exchange Visitor or acquiring such status after admission shall be eligible to apply for immigrant visa, or for non-immigrant visa under section 101(a)(15)(H) until it is established that such person has resided and been physically present in the country of his nationality or his last residence or in another foreign country for at least two years following departure from the U.S. It also provides that such residence in another country shall be considered to have satisfied this requirement only if the U.S. Secretary of State determines that such residence has served the purpose and intent of the Act.
- b. This grant supplements the accompanying U.S. Government grant which provides for your support for the specified period.
- c. Neither USIEF nor the U.S. Government, nor the IIE, assumes any responsibility for injury, accident, sickness, or other contingency which may arise in connection with the grantee's activities, educational or otherwise, or those of his/her dependents, during or as a result of his/her stay in the United States of during travel.

The final authority to decide the routing rests with USIEF at all times.

Difference in air fare and the taxes for any travel other than your entitlement, incorporated in the air ticket must to be paid by you to USIEF prior to the collection of your tickets.

You need to submit a copy of your passport and a copy of your U.S. visa to USIEF.

If travel involves obtaining visa(s) to countries other than the U.S., it will be entirely your responsibility. USIEF cannot provide any assistance in this matter.

The Fulbright grant does not provide for fees for passports or visas or any expenses related to medical insurance and check ups incurred for travel. These are your responsibility.

In case you choose to travel on a lower/cheaper fare/class for any reason whatsoever, the savings resulting out of such cheaper travel will revert to USIEF and cannot be applied directly or indirectly towards the cost of your personal travel or for your dependent's travel or any expenses.

Once the ticket is purchased, any re-routing, revalidation or change or date etc. has to be done by you at your expense.

In no case will grantees be handed over the cash equivalent to their transportation entitlement.

If the within India travel arrangements needs to be made by the grantee himself/herself for any reason whatsoever, reimbursement will be made only with prior approval of USIEF which should indicate the cost of travel.

## **TRAVEL OUTSIDE THE U.S. DURING THE GRANT**

Fulbright-Nehru Doctoral Research Fellows are strongly encouraged to pursue their grants in the U.S., including internships, data collection or practicum requirements. Visiting student researchers, regardless of the duration of their grant, are permitted a cumulative total of 14 days of personal leave (including travel days) outside the U.S.

All grantees should seek USIEF approval in addition to writing to IIE should they plan to travel outside the U.S. during the course of their grant for any purpose. Requests must be made at least two weeks prior to the scheduled trip. The grantee should send the request through email to Sudarsan, Pratibha and the IIE advisor who will process the request and inform the grantee.

Grantees cannot avail of this personal leave at the end of their grant period.

Any travel outside of U.S. without the written consent of USIEF will result in the immediate suspension and possible revocation of the Fulbright-Nehru grant.

## **EARLY DEPARTURE**

All early departure requests will require USIEF approval. Grantees are advised to seek USIEF approval in addition to writing to IIE should they plan to depart early.

Stipend will be deducted for the number of days that the grantee is departing early.

This fellowship will enable you to pursue studies at **Beijing Language and Culture University** in the field of **Chinese Language**, as a **General Scholar**, from 1 September 2017 to 15 July 2018.

Upon receipt of this letter, it is imperative that you send back **within three days** the enclosed *Statement of Acceptance*, dated and signed, to Mr Stoyan Bantchev, Chief of the Participation Programme and Fellowships Section ([s.bantchev@unesco.org](mailto:s.bantchev@unesco.org)), with copy to [b.qin@unesco.org](mailto:b.qin@unesco.org) and [v.lopy@unesco.org](mailto:v.lopy@unesco.org), thereby confirming that you accept all the terms and conditions of the fellowship stipulated in this letter. It is also mandatory to specify in the *Statement of Acceptance* the name of your host university, the start and the end date of your academic year (for which, you are advised to consult your host university for a precise academic calendar).

#### 1. PRE-REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

You are required to obtain a student visa (X visa) from the nearest Chinese Embassy/Consulate before your departure to China. According to the rules and regulation of the Chinese Government, you are required to prepare the **original** documents listed below:

- Passport and identical photos;
- Admission Notice*;
- The Form of Visa Application for Study in China (JW 201)*;
- Academic diplomas;
- Physical Examination Record for Foreigners duly completed by a certified hospital with qualified test facilities; and
- Blood test reports.

The Chinese Embassies/Consulates in some countries may have different requirements and procedures for visa application. Therefore, when preparing your visa application documents, you shall refer to the information and guidance given by the Chinese Embassy/Consulate where you are going to apply for your student visa.

#### IMPORTANT:

You shall be certified as medically fit for your studies in China. Failure to obtain medical clearance will lead to the automatic cancellation of this fellowship. During your stay in China, you are obliged to inform any change of physical conditions to the relevant office of your host university.

## 2. REGISTRATION

Upon your arrival at the place of study in China, you must be present in person with all the documents required above for the registration formalities.

## 3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AWARD

### a) Facilities Offered by the Government of the People's Republic of China

- i) Tuition Waiver;
- ii) Monthly Stipends:  
CNY 3000 (three thousand Chinese yuan) for general scholars; or CNY 3500 (three thousand five hundred Chinese yuan) for senior scholars to cover meals and living expense;
- iii) Accommodation: Free University Dormitory, or Accommodation Subsidy;

If the host university requires students to live on campus, the university will accommodate fellows in university dormitory (usually twin rooms); if the host university permits students to live off-campus, the university will provide monthly or quarterly accommodation subsidy as standard stipulated below:

General scholars: CNY 700 (seven hundred Chinese yuan) per month;

Senior scholars: CNY 1000 (one thousand Chinese yuan) per month.

- iv) Comprehensive Medical Insurance and Protection Scheme for International Students in China.

### IMPORTANT:

Fellows need to cover the medical expenses below the health insurance rebate threshold. Fellows should carefully refer to the policy terms and conditions provided by the insurance company when claiming for compensations. In most cases, the insurance company will request relevant documents and payment receipts. Any claim without justifiable evidence will be refused by the insurance company.

### b) Facilities Offered by UNESCO

- i) International Travel  
UNESCO will provide a round-trip air travel ticket between your home country and China. You are requested to send the scanned copy of your passport and a proposal of your travel itinerary to [b.qin@unesco.org](mailto:b.qin@unesco.org), with copy to Mr Stoyan Bantchev, Chief of the Participation Programme and Fellowships Section ([s.bantchev@unesco.org](mailto:s.bantchev@unesco.org)) and [v.lopy@unesco.org](mailto:v.lopy@unesco.org) within 10 days of receipt of this letter.

**You shall depart from your home country to China on 29 August 2017 at the earliest and leave China on 15 July 2018 at the latest.**

**Once this round-trip air ticket is bought and confirmed, any charge or fee incurred by the modification of tickets or excess luggage will be at your expense.** Therefore, when preparing your travel itinerary, you shall take into due consideration the time for visa application in your country and the academic calendar of your host university.

- ii) A Monthly Supplementary Allowance  
In addition to the stipends granted by the Government of the People's Republic of China, UNESCO will offer a monthly supplementary allowance of USD 80 (eighty US dollars) from **the month that you arrive in China to 15 July 2018**, provided that you are physically present and complete your study at the host university in China.

- iii) **A Termination Allowance**  
UNESCO will grant a total sum of USD 200 (two hundred US dollars) to cover the charges for extra and overweight luggage when you go back to your home country.

The supplementary monthly allowance and the termination allowance will be transferred directly to your bank account in China in three instalments during your stay in China:

1st instalment of allowance	From the month of your arrival in China to January 2018 (5 months for fellows who arrive in September; for those who arrive in China in October or even later, the allowance for previous months will be automatically deducted)
2nd instalment of allowance	From February 2018 to June 2018 (5 months)
3rd instalment of allowance	Half-month supplementary allowance (USD 40) for July 2018 plus USD 200 termination allowance

In order to activate the first instalment of your allowance, once you arrive in China, you need to open a bank account (preferably in the Bank of China) and send the completed *Annex I: Form of Banking Details* to b.qin@unesco.org and v.lopy@unesco.org, attached with the scanned copy of a document officially issued by your bank with the account information precisely corresponding to the information given in the completed form.

The second and the third instalments of your allowance will be transferred to your bank account in China only after you submit to UNESCO an *Interim Report* (before 15 February 2018) and a comprehensive *Final Report* (before 31 May 2018). A copy of the final report should also be sent to the China Scholarship Council (address: No. 160 Fuxingmennei Dajie, Beijing 100031).

You can refer to *Annex II: UNESCO Timetable for Fellows 2017-2018* for an overview of the timeframe on reports submission and allowance distribution. You shall be aware that it requires two to six weeks to register your banking information in UNESCO's automated payment system in order to activate the first instalment of allowance. The transfer of allowance from UNESCO to your Chinese account will also take five to ten working days. To ensure that you can receive the allowance from UNESCO in time, you shall submit your banking information and reports in accordance with the requirements and deadlines stipulated above and in Annex II and I. UNESCO will not take responsibility for any delay of allowance distribution caused by incorrectly provided banking information or disrespect to the stipulated deadlines.

c) **Other Terms and Conditions**

In any circumstance, if you decide to terminate your studies before the completion of the programme to which this fellowship is granted, this fellowship will be terminated automatically. Allowance payments will stop on the date that you terminate your studies and all the cost and expense for your return to your home country will be at your expense.

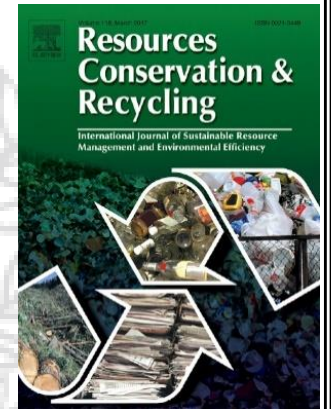



- a. Duration of grant is specified in item 4 above.
- b. Full-time Nature of the Grant: This grant is made for the purpose of full-time study/training/research. Grantees are not permitted to accept remuneration from outside agencies.

### **2. Termination of the Grant**

- a. The J. William Fulbright Foreign Scholarships Board (FSB) and the Office of the Academic Program, Department of State, reserve the right to revoke or terminate this grant with concurrence of USIEF and to withhold return transportation to the home country should non-compliance with the provisions of the grant warrant such action. The host institution and the cooperating agency (IIE) may recommend revocation of a grant to the Department of State and the FSB.
- b. Grounds for revocation include, but are not limited to, the following: violation of the laws of the United States; misconduct; failure to maintain satisfactory scholastic standing; failure to carry out the professional purpose for which the grant was awarded; failure to complete the grant because of voluntary termination, including premature departure from institution of affiliation in the U.S.; engaging in political or unauthorized income producing activities; or other activities which in the discretion of the Board of Foreign Scholarships, the Department of State and USIEF are inconsistent with the purpose and best interests of the program; failure to submit the reports required by the supervising agency; physical or mental incapacitation. 

Upon receipt of this letter, it is imperative that you send back **within three days** the enclosed *Statement of Acceptance*, dated and signed, to Mr Stoyan Bantchev, Chief of the Participation Programme and Fellowships Section ([s.bantchev@unesco.org](mailto:s.bantchev@unesco.org)), with copy to [b.qin@unesco.org](mailto:b.qin@unesco.org) and [v.lopy@unesco.org](mailto:v.lopy@unesco.org), thereby confirming that you accept all the terms and conditions of the fellowship stipulated in this letter. It is also mandatory to specify in the *Statement of Acceptance* the name of your host university, the start and the end date of your academic year (for which, you are advised to consult your host university for a precise academic calendar).

#### 1. PRE-REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

You are required to obtain a student visa (X visa) from the nearest Chinese Embassy/Consulate before your departure to China. According to the rules and regulation of the Chinese Government, you are required to prepare the **original** documents listed below:

- Passport and identical photos;
- Admission Notice*;
- The Form of Visa Application for Study in China (JW 201)*;
- Academic diplomas;
- Physical Examination Record for Foreigners duly completed by a certified hospital with qualified test facilities; and
- Blood test reports.

The Chinese Embassies/Consulates in some countries may have different requirements and procedures for visa application. General scholars: CNY 700 (seven hundred Chinese yuan) per month;

Senior scholars: CNY 1000 (one thousand Chinese yuan) per month.

- iv) Comprehensive Medical Insurance and Protection Scheme for International Students in China.

### IMPORTANT:

Fellows need to cover the medical expenses below the health insurance rebate threshold. Fellows should carefully refer to the policy terms and conditions provided by the insurance company when claiming for compensations. In most cases, the insurance company will request relevant documents and payment receipts. Any claim without justifiable evidence will be refused by the insurance company.

### b) Facilities Offered by UNESCO

- i) International Travel  
UNESCO will provide a round-trip air travel ticket between your home country and China. You are requested to send the scanned copy of your passport and a proposal of your travel itinerary to [b.qin@unesco.org](mailto:b.qin@unesco.org), with copy to Mr Stoyan Bantchev, Chief of the Participation Programme and Fellowships Section ([s.bantchev@unesco.org](mailto:s.bantchev@unesco.org)) and [v.lopy@unesco.org](mailto:v.lopy@unesco.org) within 10 days of receipt of this letter.

**You shall depart from your home country to China on 29 August 2017 at the earliest and leave China on 15 July 2018 at the latest.**

**Once this round-trip air ticket is bought and confirmed, any charge or fee incurred by the modification of tickets or excess luggage will be at your expense.** Therefore, when preparing your travel itinerary, you shall take into due consideration the time for visa application in your country and the academic calendar of your host university.

- ii) A Monthly Supplementary Allowance  
In addition to the stipends granted by the Government of the People's Republic of China, UNESCO will offer a monthly supplementary allowance of USD 80 (eighty US dollars) from **the month that you arrive in China to 15 July 2018**, provided that you are physically present and complete your study at the host university in China.

- iii) **A Termination Allowance**  
UNESCO will grant a total sum of USD 200 (two hundred US dollars) to cover the charges for extra and overweight luggage when you go back to your home country.

The supplementary monthly allowance and the termination allowance will be transferred directly to your bank account in China in three instalments during your stay in China:

1st instalment of allowance	From the month of your arrival in China to January 2018 (5 months for fellows who arrive in September; for those who arrive in China in October or even later, the allowance for previous months will be automatically deducted)
2nd instalment of allowance	From February 2018 to June 2018 (5 months)
3rd instalment of allowance	Half-month supplementary allowance (USD 40) for July 2018 plus USD 200 termination allowance

In order to activate the first instalment of your allowance, once you arrive in China, you need to open a bank account (preferably in the Bank of China) and send the completed *Annex I: Form of Banking Details* to [b.qin@unesco.org](mailto:b.qin@unesco.org) and [v.lopy@unesco.org](mailto:v.lopy@unesco.org), attached with the scanned copy of a document officially issued by your bank with the account information precisely corresponding to the information given in the completed form.

The second and the third instalments of your allowance will be transferred to your bank account in China only after you submit to UNESCO an *Interim Report* (before 15 February 2018) and a comprehensive *Final Report* (before 31 May 2018). A copy of the final report should also be sent to the China Scholarship Council (address: No. 160 Fuxingmennei Dajie, Beijing 100031).

You can refer to *Annex II: UNESCO Timetable for Fellows 2017-2018* for an overview of the timeframe on reports submission and allowance distribution. You shall be aware that it requires two to six weeks to register your banking information in UNESCO's automated payment system in order to activate the first instalment of allowance. The transfer of allowance from UNESCO to your Chinese account will also take five to ten working days. To ensure that you can receive the allowance from UNESCO in time, you shall submit your banking information and reports in accordance with the requirements and deadlines stipulated above and in Annex II and I. UNESCO will not take responsibility for any delay of allowance distribution caused by incorrectly provided banking information or disrespect to the stipulated deadlines.

c) **Other Terms and Conditions**

In any circumstance, if you decide to terminate your studies before the completion of the programme to which this fellowship is granted, this fellowship will be terminated automatically. Allowance payments will stop on the date that you terminate your studies and all the cost and expense for your return to your home country will be at your expense.

No extension of fellowship, claim or expense other than the facilities and conditions stipulated in this award letter will be granted by UNESCO and the Government of China. Additional expenditures incurred in the process of visa application and your travel between China and your home country, including the


cost and fees for visa application, accommodation, meals and insurance during transit and prolonged stay in China will be at your own expense.

This fellowship has no provision to finance or lodge any family member of the fellow.

Fellows shall conduct themselves at all times, as befits the holders of the fellowships granted by an organization of the United Nations System. Fellows shall avoid any act or any public pronouncement that could be detrimental to UNESCO or the status as a UNESCO fellow. Fellows are requested not to speak in public or give interview other than their particular field of competence and subject, which is subject to prior consultation with UNESCO. This provision does not debar fellows from speaking freely in informal gathering, on the condition that the fellows bear in mind their obligation as UNESCO fellows. Fellows shall also respect different culture and promote international understanding in their social activities.

You are requested to inform directly and timely the Embassy/Consulate of your country in China and the host university of the flight that you are expected to take from your country to China and the exact time of your arrival. It is imperative for you to confirm your arrival to the Participation Programme and Fellowships Section as soon as you arrive in China. You shall direct all future correspondence with UNESCO to Mr Stoyan Bantchev, Chief of the Participation Programme and Fellowships Section (s.bantchev@unesco.org), with a copy to b.qin@unesco.org.

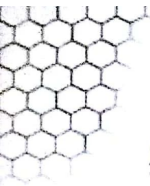

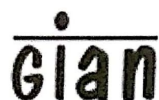

**“DEVELOPMENT OF VEGETABLE OIL-BASED NON-ISOCYANATE POLYURETHANE THROUGH CO<sub>2</sub> INSERTION AND  
ITS COATING APPLICATION: GREEN METHODOLOGY WITH MITIGATION OF GREENHOUSE GAS”**

**Shri Simanta Doley & Dr. Swapan K. Dolui**

Polyurethanes are an exceptional group of polymeric material which is globally the sixth most extensively used polymer. This unique polymer demonstrates excellent mechanical and physical properties like abrasive resistance, flexibility, chemical resistance, toughness and durability etc. However, traditionally Polyurethanes are synthesized by the polymerization reaction between short and long chain polyol and polyisocyanate which are petroleum-based.

Since isocyanates are petroleum dependent as well as highly toxic chemicals, so from the viewpoint of environment-friendly, health and economy, development of non-isocyanate Polyurethanes (so-called NIPUs) mainly those made from renewable resources is very important.

In this regard, they have prepared sunflower oil based non-isocyanate polyurethanes by utilizing the green house gas CO<sub>2</sub>. Firstly, sunflower oil based cyclic carbonates were synthesized by reaction of epoxidized sunflower oil with CO<sub>2</sub> which is further reacts with different amine to give NIPUs. Further, the nanocomposites of the prepared NIPUs were synthesized. The prepared NIPUs exhibited a tensile strength (5.2 MPa), corrosion rate (0.0391504 mmpy) and its nanocomposites with multi walled carbon nanotubes (MWCNTs) showed an improved tensile strength (8.92 MPa), better flame retardancy properties (LOI= 30%) and microwave absorbance behavior (-17 dB).
