





**Memorandum of Understanding
Academic cooperation between
Tezpur University
and
The University of Auckland**

The Vice Chancellor of Tezpur University and the Dean of Creative Arts and Industries of the University of Auckland hereby propose to foster academic exchange and cooperation between the two institutions.

1. The two institutions will encourage the following activities in particular:
 - 1) Exchange of material, publications and information.
 - 2) Exchange of staff and students
 - 3) Cooperative research between research staff at both Universities
 - 4) Joint research and meetings for research and curriculum development.
2. These activities are to be carried out after mutual consultation between the two institutions or the divisions concerned thereof. Normally each institution will sign a letter of agreement setting out the responsibilities of each institution for the agreed activities and such other matters as the institutions agree are necessary for the efficient achievement of the activity.
3. Amendment of this memorandum is to be effected by a written agreement of the two institutions. No such amendment or revision will come into effect until both institutions have agreed in writing to this amendment or revision.
4. **This memorandum will be effective upon approval by both parties in writing and shall remain in effect for a period of five years.** Thereafter, subject to a review by each institution which confirms the memorandum is achieving its objectives set out above, may be extended for a further term of five years as may be agreed by both parties in writing. However, after the initial term, either party may terminate the agreement at the end of a given academic year by giving six months' notice in writing of such intent, provided that termination by one party shall not affect any activities already approved under this memorandum.


