1. Background

The government of India has a target to install 100 GW of solar power by 2022. To fulfil the targeted capacity and for effective operation and maintenance there will be a need of skilled man power in the field of solar energy. However there is lack of proper infrastructure, target based curriculum, lack of certification, deficiency of aspiration and motivation. To overcome these hurdles, Prime Minister Office initiated a dream project “Skilling India” for unemployed youths of India with a target to generate 500 million skilled man powers in different target sectors. Renewable Energy is one of the target areas with big emphasis on solar energy and in particular solar photovoltaics.

The Ministry of New Renewable Energy, Government of India has taken an initiative to installed 100 GW solar project by 2022 in co-ordination with State Nodal Agencies. However, there are gaps in the capacity and quality of training infrastructure as well as outputs, insufficient focus on workforce aspirations, lack of certification and common standards and a pointed lack of focus on the unorganized sector. In order to achieve this mission more than 50,000 skilled manpower are required for installation, commissioning, operation and maintenance in the field of solar energy. National Institute of Solar Energy (an autonomous institute under the Ministry of New & Renewable Energy) has been given the responsibility to organise the various skill development programmes in solar photovoltaics in association with state nodal agencies throughout the country. National Institute of Solar Energy (NISE) started the skilled development program in the area of photovoltaics with a program name called “Suryamitra Skill Development Program”. NISE in association with state nodal agencies has selected numbers of training centres in the country to conduct the program based on the expression of interest submitted by those institutes or organisations. The institutes or organisations are selected based on the facility and infrastructure available for conduct a quality skill development program of 90 days.

2. Genesis of Suryamitra Skilled Development Program in Tezpur University

As per the background of skill development program Tezpur University submitted the expression of interest to be a training institute for Suryamitra Skill Development Program on 28th October 2015. The program is coordinated by three interested faculty members Prof. Debendra Chandra Baruah, Sadhan Mahapatra and Dr. Nabin Sarmah. The University administration and coordinator was informed about the selection of Tezpur University as

training centre through a letter dated 23rd November 2015. With the selection as training Institute for Suryamitra Skill Development Program, coordinator started the initiative and it was decided to start the program by March 2016. A notice about program was published on ‘The Assam Tribune’ and ‘Amar Asom’ on 25th January 2016, with detailed advertisement at the Tezpur University website along with the application form. A decent number of responses were received with application, so a second round advertisement was floated as scrolled display for 2 days in a regional news channel DY-365. The number of application increased and it was decided to start the program from 1st April 2016. Meantime Circulation for State Assembly Election of Assam was announced and the process to start the program delayed; so a final date of 2nd May 2016 was agreed. The final list of the selected participants was uploaded in the Tezpur University website and informed all the selected participants over telephone.

3. The Program Implementation Strategy in Tezpur University

Since the Suryamitra program has a curriculum which needs expertise in different domains such as electrical engineering, electronics engineering, mechanical engineering, civil engineering, it was decided to form a committee having faculty coordinators from different Departments for smooth conduction of the program. With the approval of Vice-chancellor and agreed by the Heads of the different Departments, few faculty members and technical staffs of various engineering departments are requested to take theory and laboratory classes.

The accommodations for the participants were arranged in the different hostels of Tezpur University separately for boys and girls. Similarly the foods for the participants were arranged in the utility facility available in the University campus. A good quality food with a dynamic menu was agreed with the service provider.

4. Execution of the Program in Tezpur University

The numbers of participants registered for the program on 1st May 2016 are 37. The participants were provided a file cover, note books, pen and study material based on the curriculum, which were found suitable for the program. A class schedule is prepared to accommodate the classes of the Suryamitra program uninterrupted without affecting the normal theory and laboratory class schedule of the other courses. While preparing the class schedule the guideline for the Suryamitra curriculum was thoroughly followed. As per the guideline more emphasis was given to the laboratory/practical classes and the participants

were provided ample time and opportunity to work with the practical/laboratory set-ups. The participants spent 600 working hours in the program in which approximately 480 hrs were guided work (theory and experiment) and rest 120 hours were spent by the participants to carry out various assignments and report preparation during evening hours (in computer laboratory) and weekend. The participants were encouraged to carry out assignments during weekend instead of spending leisurely hours.

As per the schedule theory classes of the different domains were taken by the experts of the Departments and practical/laboratory classes were done in the respective Departmental laboratories guided by the technical staff of the Department. The faculty members of Tezpur University involved in the theory classes is given in Appendix – III.

During the program three guest trainers were invited to take classes on the different aspects of PV system and components:

- i. Mr. Rama Siva (CEO, AnthroPower, New Delhi)
- ii. Mr. Sanjeev Sarma (Entrepreneur, Electro Sales, Guwahati)
- iii. Mr Fazle Illahi (DGM, Eastern Envo Projects)
- iv. Mr Madhurjya Baruah (Engineer, Jain Irrigation Systems Pvt Ltd)

On a very rare opportunity Prof. H Patangia from University of Arkansas – Little Rock, USA took a class on the electronics component of PV system. Prof Patangia was visiting Tezpur University during that time, so on the request of the coordinators, he agreed to have a interaction and discussion with the participants on that topic.

During the program the participants carried out 19 experiments as given in the curriculum guideline document of Suryamitra program. There were three field trips organised during the program:

- i. 33kV power sub-station of Tezpur University
- ii. 15 kW_p PV roof installation in Hazarapar, Tezpur
- iii. 3 kW_p PV installation on fuel station, Thelamara

Moreover, numbers of assignments were carried out by the participants in the area of standalone street light PV system design and installation, maintenance of the PV systems (1kW PV system in the Department of Energy and existing solar street light system of Tezpur

University). Furthermore, detail component pricing analysis and component search in the internet was also guided to the participants. It is expected that the field trip, experiments and assignments have a strong understanding and exposure on the PV system to the participants. The Suryamitra Skill Development program in Tezpur University completed on 30th of July and 30 successful participants of the first batch were awarded certificate in a valedictory function.

5. Assessment and Certification

The assessment of the participants of the program was carried out on 29th July 2016. The assessment was done with a set of question papers (Part-I and Part-II), which includes objective type, descriptive type and numerical questions. The questions were set by the trainers (both in-house and guest trainers) which was compiled in two parts for convenience. A laboratory note book from all the participants were asked to submit in which theory and experiments are described with the results and discussion. A quiz on the laboratory experiments was arranged for evaluation based on the experiment performed. To assess the soft skill of the participants a session on the presentation on topic of interest was carried out. Based on these parameters the assessment of the participants of the Suryamitra Skill Development Program was carried out.

The successful participants on these assessments were issued a certificate signed by the Director of AEDA (State Nodal Agency coordinating the Suryamitra Program with NISE) and joint coordinator of the Suryamitra Skill Development Program in Tezpur University.

6. The valedictory Function

The valedictory function organised to distribute the certificate to the Suryamitras. The function was graced by Director, Assam Science Technology and Environment Council (ASTECC) and Assam Energy Development Agency (AEDA) Dr. Arup Misra; Additional director AEDA, Mr. Mrinal Chaudhury; Registrar of Tezpur University Dr. Biren Das; Entrepreneur Mr Sanjeev Sarma. The program started with felicitation of invited guests. To begin with, Joint coordinator of the program Professor Debendra Chandra Baruah welcomed all the invited guests and participants to the function and mentioned genesis of the program in Tezpur University. He also mentioned the contributions that higher education institutes can play in this type of skill development programs. The chief guest Dr Arup Misra congratulated all the Suryamitras on successful completion of the program. He mentioned that with

government of initiatives with campaigns like 'Make in India' there will be a huge demand of skilled persons in different technical requirements. He also mentioned that Suryamitras are going to play a big role in the ambitious project of Government of India in generation 100 gigawatts of power from solar photovoltaics. Mr Mrinal Krishna Chaudhury also mentioned the opportunities of Suryamitra in current energy demand scenario and highlighted some successful employment of other suryamitras in different corporate sectors and becoming entrepreneur. Dr. Biren Das congratulated all the successful participants and acknowledged the contribution and hard of all the stakeholders in smooth conduction of the program in Tezpur University. Mr Sanjeeb Sarma in his speech mentioned that the Suryamitras should target to be an entrepreneur, where they can provide employment to others. He also promised all round support to the suryamitras to start business or for employment. In the speech from the participants, three participants Dhruba Krishna Deka, Arifa Sidikki Ahmed and Dipankar Neog expressed their thoughts and comments about the program and the learnings. They mentioned that the program was useful to them and they have gained motivation and confidence both in technical and entrepreneurship aspects in the area of solar photovoltaics.

Towards the end of the function, joint coordinator Dr Nabin Sarmah offered the vote of thanks. He acknowledged the support and co-operation from Tezpur University fraternity; AEDA; NISE and other stakeholders. He also congratulated and thanked the participants for being part of such a visionary program from government if India. The program ended with thanks to the invited guest and all the audience present in the function. A group photo of the Suryamitras was taken along with the invited guests and coordinators.

An informal interaction of Suryamitras was organised with the Director and Additional director of AEDA after the valedictory function, where different aspects and future prospects of the Suryamitras were discussed.

7. Conclusions

The Suryamitra Skill Development Program conducted at Tezpur University is successfully completed with all round benefit of the successful participants. There is no doubt that higher education can play a big role in this kind of skill development program because of quality manpower and infrastructure available.

It is to be mentioned that in some aspects is not convenient to entirely follow the guidelines of the Suryaimtra Skill Development program prepared by NISE. In one of such cases total working hours to be given range to complete the course curriculum. Since the numbers of days of the program to be fixed (considering the accommodation and utility expenditures) and vacation or holidays on between causes difficulty in fulling the total 600 working hours given in the guidelines within 90 days; specially for central government organisation where there is policy of 5 working days in a week.

In another note, the internship arrangement (session 16) for the Suryamitra participants should be provided by the State Nodal Agency and NISE in partner with industry/project site. It may not be easy for training institute to arrange internship for the participants in industry/project site, if there no such facility available locally.

It is expected that the Suryamitra Skill Development Program can generate skilled man power that can fulfil the demand of solar technicians in achieving the dream of 100GW power generation from solar energy.

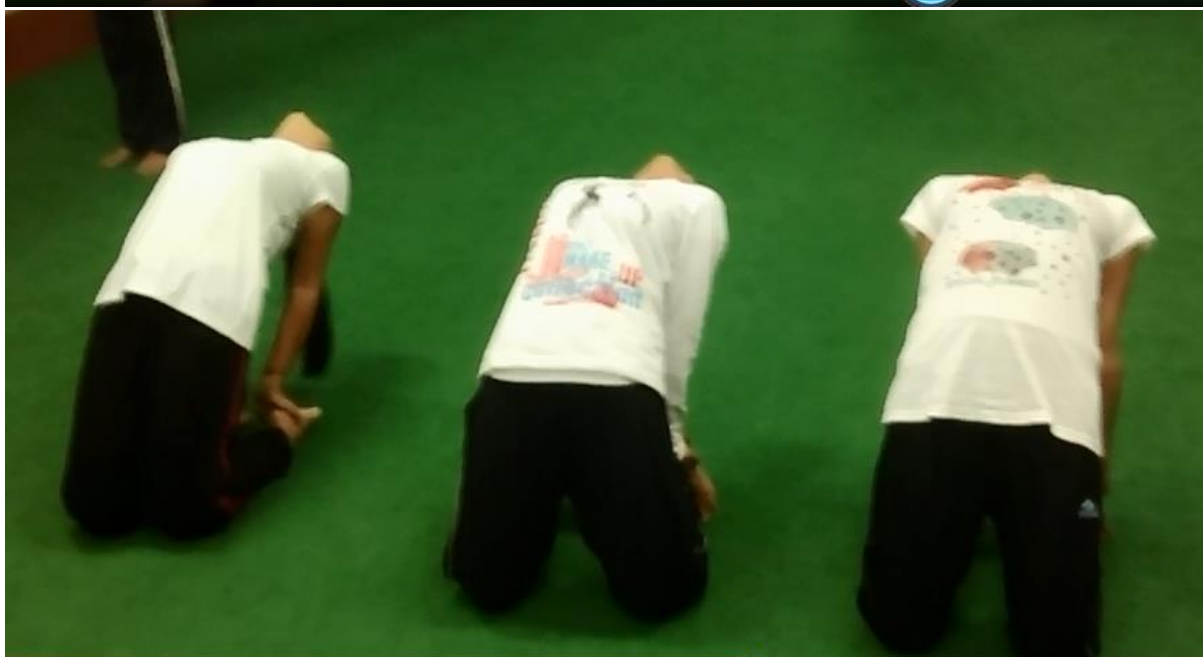

Workshop on Women and Violence

20-08-2016 to 31-08-2016

Workshop on Women and Violence

29-31 August 2016

BACKGROUND:

Tezpur University is a central university established in 1994 by an act of parliament. Since then the university has emerged as a premier institute of science and technology with a strong focus on socio – cultural development within the region.

INTRODUCTION:

Earlier the department of mass communication and journalism has already organized many such workshops. But this is the first workshop for the communication for development programme which was officially inaugurated this very year on the 26th August 2016. This workshop was organized under the guidance of Mrs. Anjuman Borah. Through this workshop we had the opportunity to interact with Dr. Monisha Behal who is the executive director and founder of the North East Network and Mrs. Sheetal Sharma works as project manager in North East Network which is a women's organization based in the northeast region.

About NEN- North east network is a women's organization working in the northeast region of India with a focus on women's human rights. Ever since its inception in 1995 their role has been that of a facilitator to empower women of northeast around issues of livelihood, health, conflict and governance through capacity building, awareness raising, networking, research and advocacy. Their work has been aimed at bringing out gendered understandings of human right situations in the region whether it's in the context of violence, livelihood, conflict, natural resource management or health.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE WORKSHOP:

1. To know more about 'feminism'.
2. Existing gender division of labour.
3. To know the deep impacts of Patriarchy.

4. To make us aware of the acts/laws protecting the rights of women.

DAY ONE (29th AUGUST 2016)

Day one of the workshop started the small inaugural session. Our guide Maam Mrs. Anjuman Bora introduced us to Dr. Monisha Behal and Maam Sheetal. They have been associated with NEN since a long time. After our introduction Dr. Monisha gave us an insight about NEN and how it works. They started off the workshop discussing how gender and sex works. They explained us the exact difference between these two terms that is gender is socially constructed and sex is biologically constructed. How everything is based on gender and it is difficult to change these rules which have been continuing in the society since a long time. On the first day they explained us about three important topics that is:

- Gender/Sex
- Patriarchy
- CEDAW

The second most important topic that our mentors dwelt upon was Patriarchy. Patriarchy is a social system in which adult males hold primary position in the society. There are different views regarding patriarchy and they are –

- Traditionalistic view –
- Pseudo-Scientist view
- Radical Feminist view
- Marxist Feminist View
- Socialist Feminist view

- We also learnt about the Hindu Succession Act which was passed in 2005. Through this act Hindu women were entitled to equal property rights.
- We were screened a small animated video made by UNICEF called “The Impossible Dream” which showcases a woman’s endless struggles and her shattered dreams.

The third most important topic was CEDAW that is “The Convention on the Elimination of all Forms of Discrimination against Women”. Article 1 of the convention on the elimination of all forms of discrimination against women (1979) defines the discrimination against women as ‘any distinction, exclusion or restriction

made on the basis of sex which has the effect or purpose of impairing or nullifying the reorganization, enjoyment or exercise by women, irrespective of their marital status on a basis of equality of men and women, of human rights and fundamental freedom in the political, economic, social, cultural, civil or any other field. It is often described as an international bill of rights for women.

Our mentors also discussed with us about the concept of equality and how equality should be in terms of access, opportunity and outcome. Access in case of how both the sexes should have equal access to resources and rights. Opportunity in terms of how both the sexes should have equal opportunities in every sphere of life for example in job sectors etc. Outcomes in terms of how every outcome should be equal.

We also learnt about the various principles of equality which are-

SAMENESS APPROACH – Assuming that boy and girl have the same strength and they can do same type of work physically.

PROTECTIONIST APPROACH – Women are denied equality of opportunity on the ground that denial is in their best interest. This approach recognizes the problem as a weakness or inferiority in women and not in the environment which needs to be corrected.

SUBSTANTIVE APPROACH – This approach recognizes that women are in unequal position and may have to be treated differently in order to benefit equally. It ensures equality of results, and not only of means.

ACTIVITIES:

We were assigned various activities that day. During the first half of the workshop we were divided into two different groups under the category of rural men and rural women. On different charts we had to showcase their working hours and define the amount of work and rest hours they have the entire day. Through this activity our mentors wanted us to know about the working patterns of an average rural men and women and how much rest they get during the entire day. This activity actually showed us the difference in the amount of work between a man and a woman and the difference in the rest hours between them.

DAY TWO (30th AUGUST 2016)

It was 30th August 2016, the second day of our workshop with North East Network (NEN) under the mentors of madam Monisha Behal and the program assistant of NEN, madam Sheetal Sharma.

- The day started with the introduction of various acts and laws for protecting the rights of women. Acts like Criminal Law Amendment Act 2013, ICRW and CEDAW. And we were also asked to present our views on how the rights of women can be violated.
- The Criminal Law (Amendment) Act, 2013 is an Indian legislation passed by the Lok Sabha on 19 March 2013, and by the Rajya Sabha on 21 March 2013, which provides for amendment of Indian Penal Code, Indian Evidence Act, and Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 on laws related to sexual offences.
- ICRW has been the world's premier applied research institute focused on women and girls for almost four decades. Their evidence-based insight seeks to optimize programs, influence policies and identify scalable solutions that help them lead safer, healthier and more empowered lives.
- The Convention on the Elimination of all Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW) is an international treaty adopted in 1979 by the United Nations General Assembly.
- And apart from that we had discussions on many other social problems in which woman are preyed by the society. The Spiral of Violence, womb to tomb were many such terms through which we came across and the impacts and outcomings were explained.
- Spiral of violence was discussed in which we came across the violation of women rights since their womb to tomb. The rights of women are violated not even before their birth, even the foetus has to go through stages of violence, (female foeticide, discrimination in providing proper nutrients during pregnancy of the mother), infancy (female infanticide, sexual violence), childhood (sexual harassment, incest, child marriage, objectification of female body), teenage (restricted mobility, voyeurism, violation of reproductive health rights), adulthood (stereotyping female, discrimination in jobs, dowry,

physical/verbal/emotional violence, marital rape, sexual violence in conflict, acid attacks, forced disrobing) and also in old age.

- The Awareness Videos like “It’s my Fault”, “Bell Bajao - got milk?”, “boys don’t cry” were screened made by some leading organisations like Vogue India, Drishti and ICRW. These videos are made in order to make people aware and make them learn to raise their voice against violence that are existing in our society against women.
- We also came across the story of Birubala Rabha, who has been tirelessly fighting the cause of witch hunting since 1980’s. Witch-hunting is a process of tracking down people deemed as witches, which often involves episodes of public frenzy. Although it seems like an outdated idea and concept, remotely rural Assam, witch-hunting is not uncommon.

DAY THREE (31st August 2016)

MORNING SESSION (10:30am onwards)

1. The session started with a recap of the previous day. One by one, the participants shared their individual experiences. The participants spoke about their learning from the interactive sessions of the previous day.
2. After this, the participants were introduced to the *Protection of Women against Domestic Violence Act, 2005 (PWDVA)* which is a civil and secular law that addresses the needs of women in situations of violence and applies to women of all communities. It also categorically recognizes the right of a woman to live a life free from violence and also to reside in a shared household. This act also expands the definition of violence to include mental, verbal, physical and economic abuse and threats and demands for dowry. It is applicable not only to married women but all women in a family as well as women in relationships akin to marriage. The resource person then discussed about the *Domestic Incidence Report (DIR)*. DIR is similar to FIR but this is filed only in case of domestic violence.
3. The NEN team then showed a video titled *AIB: Rape-It’s your Fault* by All

India Bakchod which responds to the string of abusive and hateful remarks made by people against women.

4. After the video, they discussed about the ***Sexual Harassment of Women at the Work Place Act, 2013 (SHWWP)*** and showed a video on ***Laws against Sexual Harassment of Women*** so that the participants get a better idea of the act. This act says that the sexual harassment against women can be categorized into two segments: one 'quid pro quo' which means 'this for that' underlining sexual harassment caused by those in authority/power in workplace resulting in noticeable or tangible employment related action. The second one is 'hostile work environment' in which the abuse does not result in tangible employment action but creates an unfriendly working environment making a women employee uncomfortable or threatened. In both cases, the women can make a complain to the following ***Internal Complaints Committee (ICC)*** for organizations with more than 10 employees or ***Local Complaints Committee (LCC)*** for organizations with less than 10 employees.

OUTCOMES OF THE SESSION:

- The participants were able to understand the issues concerning women in a more detailed manner from a broader perspective of law and justice.
- The session made the participants aware of the two acts namely;
 - Protection of Women against Domestic Violence Act, 2005 (PWDVA) and;
 - Sexual Harassment of Women at the Work Place Act, 2013 (SHWWP)

CONCLUDING SESSION:

During the concluding session, Ms. Anjuman Borah, the coordinator of the workshop asked for experiences, feedback, queries and suggestions from the participants in context of the three-day workshop by the North-east Network, held in the Department of Mass Communication and Journalism, Tezpur University. Ms. Chayanika Baruah and Mr. Sujit Muktan shared their experiences on behalf of all the participants of the workshop. After that Ms. Anjuman Borah, the coordinator of the workshop offered the vote of thanks.



INTRODUCTION

A one day workshop was conducted by the department of Mass Communication and journalism for the students of Communication for development (C4d) by a guest faculty teacher named Sam Rufus on 4th November. He taught the students on effective communication and how communication is very essential in grassroots for the development of people. The workshop was attended by 7 students of the C4d batch. The workshop was divided into four sessions.

About SAM RUFUS

Sam Rufus is the Founder-Director of EPIC(Enriching people in creativity). He has spent over three decades on the creative side of advertising with multinational agencies in India, the US and Australia. He has captured this enormous experience to take people empowerment to a different level- Human Resource Development (HRD). Sam prefers to zip all his professional competencies and experience into just two words: *learning person*

MORNING, 9 A.M

The workshop was started with an inaugural session of few minutes, where Professor Mrs. Anjuman Bora introduced the students to Sam Rufus; the students also introduced themselves to him, speaking of what has interested them to choose C4D. He told the participants that he loved to be with people, he was a commerce student studying Finance and now works for advertisements. He guided the students to learn from failure, with an example that people who sink are either they don't know to swim or they don't want to swim. He said that there is joy and thrill in learning and if one learns, one doesn't require to study. Working in the grassroots one should have a clear destination, must be impatient to achieve it. He told that to have effective communication in advertisement, one should follow the rule of AIDA, where A means attention; I for interest; D for desire and A stands for act. He said that development communication is learning, it is not mere information.

He told the participants the story of an eagle, The Eagle has the longest life-span of its species. It can live up to 70 years. But to reach this age, the eagle must make a hard decision. In its 40th year its long and flexible talons can no longer grab prey which serves as food. Its long and sharp beak becomes bent. Its old-aged and heavy wings, due to their thick feathers, stick to its chest & make it difficult to fly. Then, the eagle is left with only two options: DIE or go through a painful process of CHANGE which lasts 150 days. The process requires that the eagle fly to a mountain top and sit on its nest. There the eagle knocks its beak against a rock until it plucks it out. Then the eagle will wait for a new beak to grow back and then it will pluck out its talons. When its new talons grow back, the eagle starts plucking its old-aged feathers. And after 5 months, the eagle takes its famous flight of rebirth and lives for 30 more years. Why is change needed? Many times, in order to survive we have to start a change process. We sometimes

need to get rid of old memories, habits and other past traditions. Only freed from past burdens, can we take advantage of the present?

This story holds a strong grab in the participants mind. It helps them to have a vision and remain focused no matter what the obstacles are.

ACTIVITY

The participants were asked to list out five things that they want to change about themselves after a week. Every participant listed out five things and discussed among the class what they want to change about themselves. The faculty teacher asked the participant to work on the things they want to change after a week.

OUTCOME

Every participant was motivated to change themselves after a week that they want the change in them.

AFTER TEA BREAK

After the tea break the participants were taught about the barriers in communication. He told that in communication the message what is said by the sender may not be exactly received by the receiver the way the sender intended. There are many barriers to communication and these may occur at any stage in the communication process. Barriers may lead to your message becoming distorted and you therefore risk wasting both time and or money by confusing and misunderstanding. Effective communication involves overcoming these barriers and conveying a clear and concise message.

ACTIVITY

Mr. Sam asked one of the participants to look at a picture and communicate with the other participant draw the picture without using any body language. No one was able to draw the picture what the participant guided the others to draw.

OUTCOME

This activity helps the participant to understand that a sender takes it for granted that the receiver knows some basic things and, therefore, it is enough to tell him about the major subject matter.

AFTER LUNCH BREAK

The third session started by 3pm, where Mr. Sam showed the participants videos and pictures. He told them that development communication is about bringing light in darkness. When things are not working properly in communication, the paradigm must be changed. Everyone has different perceptions. In grassroots some people can see the government policies beneficial for them very quickly, while others may not because of the different perceptions they have because of the different barriers they are being surrounded.

According to him, C4D is a way to amplify voice, facilitate meaningful participation, and bring about a decisive social change through a process of sustained empowerment.

ACTIVITY

The participants were shown a picture, where everyone saw different things in the picture, everyone perception about the picture was different. After lot of discussions everyone was able to see the message what the picture says.

OUTCOME

The participant learned that people perceive things differently. People choose to select different aspects of a message to focus our attention based on what interests them, what is familiar to them or what they consider important.

AFTER TEA BREAK

After a break of 10 minutes, Mr. Sam taught the participants about the six different thinking hats, which are:

White hat- This covers facts, figures, information needs and gaps.

Red hat-This covers intuition, feelings and emotions.

Black hat-This is the hat of judgment and caution.

Yellow hat- This is the logical positive. Why something will work and why it will offer benefits.

Green hat- This is the hat of creativity, alternatives, proposals, what are interesting, provocations and changes.

Blue hat-This is the overview or process control hat.

He told that in working or identifying development challenges or issues one must wear the white hat, which means one must be neutral, focus on information available, objective facts, what is needed and how it can be obtained.

After the use of white hat, one must apply the green hat. This means one should be creative, in generating ideas how a problem can be handled. One must have a alternative to a idea which don't work.

CONCLUSION

After completing different activities and exercises whole day Mr. Sam Rufus gave his final lecture to the students of C4D also shared his experience of his 4 day long trip in Tezpur University especially in Mass communication and Journalism Department. At last the workshop ended with a vote of thanks given by Punam Talukdar, a student of C4D.

Workshop on C4D's Practical Application in
Development Sector

Workshop Title: C4d's Practical Application In Development Sector

Resource Person: Dr. Arbind Sinha, Director General, Shanti Business School, Ahmedabad.

Date: 24th, 25th And 26th November

INTRODUCTION

A three day long workshop was organized for the students of Communication for Development (C4D) of the department of Mass Communication and Journalism. It was conducted by Dr. Arbind Sinha, Director General of Shanti Business School, Ahmedabad and was held at the Conference room from 24th to 26th of November 2016.

With the schedule of six sessions (morning and afternoon) , the workshop went on with different activities, lectures, sharing of experiences, ideas, screening, the participants were shown different documentaries on various awareness issues and many more. Generally the workshop was on “What is Communication for Development?”; its importance with a special attention to “Health Communication”. The workshop was attended by all the students of the program of communication for development. A total number of nine participants were present in the workshop.

ABOUT THE RESOURCE PERSON

The resource person Mr. Arbind Sinha shared a number of experiences while working in this field of communication for development. He recalled those days when communication for development (C4D) was first introduced in India and how he along with his fellow colleagues worked thoroughly in growing up and understanding this field in the Indian context. The participants found the stories shared by him quite inspiring. Dr. Arbind Sinha being a graduate in Zoology got inclined

towards Anthropology and later completed his masters from Ranchi University in Anthropology, whereas did his Ph.D in Sociology afterwards. He has 24 years long field experience and 18 years of teaching experience. In different points of time he worked in different fields viz. MICA, Ahmedabad, Royal Denmark Embassy New Delhi and also in ISRO, Ahmedabad.

Day 1: 24th November,2016.

The participants were asked to state their views on development and communication and also was asked what made them choose this field of communication for development. He later after getting everyone's view presented the way how development should be viewed and for that the participants were showed a video clipping with three different tribes of Andaman and Nicobar Island where the participants had to draw out the difference in showing which tribe seemed to be more happy even after the intervention by the Indian government in facilitating their needs. In which the participants came up with different answers while it was taught that development shouldn't be imposed upon people and that it may differ from every aspect from region to region. He defined, "development should be such which shouldn't disturb the equilibrium of the environment." And that development should be such which should stay forever and never stop. It should be a psychological phenomenon (a relative perception).

Waves of education was discussed after development where the fourth wave of education i.e communication was stressed upon. Here the idea of communication was shared by every participant and later the resource person presented his view where he said communication is the transfer of information from one place to another. And also said an important point that communication for development (c4D) is the integration of strategic communication in development efforts.

On the queries questioned by the participants Mr.Sinha answered as to how a development project is to be carried out in a country like India? He answered one must know and understand the threat of any area before carrying out a project.

Indias population which is rising alarmingly and how it is posing threat to the development and growth of india was also discussed amongst all. And how communication can play a bigger role in tackling such a menace was discussed.

Communication basic Theories and models like two step model theory, bullet theory, needle theory, SMCR theory, diffusion model, development communication process model were discussed and how these theories play an important role in establishing communication was shown to the participants. Whereas a new theory developed by the resource person himself was also explained. The theory was SCHEMA theory, which is basically a development communication model.

With these activities and discussions the first day came to an end.

Day 2: 25th November, 2016.

The second day, session started in the morning where the resource person showed a power point presentation to all the participants where the meaning of communication for development was taught, C4D or Development Communication (Devcom) is the integration of strategic communication in development efforts then explained the participants why c4d is required in the present context.

By citing an example of contrasting images of India, where India is shining and on the other hand a degrading image of the periphery of the country. Problems relating to population explosion, transportation, culture, religion, climate change, environment pollution, health

hazards and social problems were shown and how development communication can play their role in these fields were discussed amongst the participants.

Stressing more on the health and healthcom he said, Health is a major concern - human sufferings, economic loss and social burden. The uptake of healthcare services, especially in the urban slums, rural and tribal areas remains low. HE, IEC, BCC, CSC, SBCC, C4D, COMBI such programs come and go, but the results are still the same except for the change in the names of the programs.

Activity: The participants were assigned a task for the afternoon session. And on that they were evaluated on how they are going to play their role as good development communicator. After completion of the task of designing a public event of swacch bharat abhiyan, Interpretation of communication was discussed next.

Day 3: 26th November, 2016.

The concept of Culture and Communication was introduced to the participants where they were explained about the idea of how culture plays its role in communication through a pictorial presentation of Bear Grylls where he can be seen travelling to different parts of the world and in return getting varied reactions from different people around the world.

Then how Behavioral Change of Communication (BCC) and Human Channel of Communication (HCC) plays a vital in communication was discussed. BCC emphasizes on research, constant push, participatory communication, and case drive whereas HCC purposely uses human beings as channel for transmitting specific messages to specific audience segments. HCC is effective in media dark areas.

The last session continued with the sharing of the experiences earned by the resource person throughout his career, and also a number of short videos were screened at last and with that the three day long workshop came to an end.

Activity: The morning session started with the division of groups amongst the participants where each group consisting of three members were handed over three leading newspapers of the state and were asked to find out the development news . Through this activity the resource person wanted to make the participants realise the amount of importance the mainstream media pays to development news.
