The committee heard the version of all the accused and victim students. The Committee found that Ms. Vinita Das was not at all involved in the incident and the complaint lodged by the victim was false and not based on the fact. Other two accused Ms. Pranamita Das and Ms. Urbashree Bayan posted a video through WhatsApp within their friend circle, but as reported in the meeting there was no mention of victim's name or photograph/ picture in the video. The victim suspected by himself that the video was made to humiliate him:

The committee reprimanded the two accused viz, Ms. Pranamita Das and Ms. Urbashree Bayan and asked to apologize before the victim ( copy enclosed). At the same time the victim has also been asked to apologize before Ms. Vinita Das who was innocent and nowhere involved in the incident. The students reciprocated accordingly before the Committee.



1. As per recommendation of the meeting of the Anti - Ragging Committee held 18.11.2019, the university has already lodged a FIR in the Borghat Police Outpost against Mr. Prantik Das vide letter no. F.27-29/2003(GA-I)/3775 dated-18.11.2019 (TZP PS Case No. 2255/19 u/s 343/294/500/306). The action has already been intimated to the Anti Ragging Help desk. Now, the police are taking action as per rules.

The Committee thoroughly deliberated the complaint of ragging (No. ARCC/AS104 dated 16.11.2019) and summoned the following students on 18.11.2019 to understand the fact of alleged ragging:

Based on the discussion with the students and statements received from them, there is no evidence that Mr. Prantik Das, the accused student ragged any student in the University. From the statements, the Committee also could not find anything to indicate that there was any face to face conversation between Mr. Prantik Das and the said victim at the site of Weakender at Shillong.

Prof. V. K. Jain, Vice Chancellor & Chairman of the Committee welcomed the members and informed them that a complaint on the MHRD Anti-Ragging helpline lodged by a student of Subansiri Women's Hostel has been received from the Supervisor of the Helpline on 4.2.2019.

The committee discussed the matter in detail. The Dean Students' Welfare and Senior Warden of the concerned hostel, who are the members of the Anti Ragging Committee, carried out preliminary investigation and met new comers of the hostel on 04.02.2019 at 7.00 p.m. to identify the victim. They reported in the meeting that they could not identify any victim as per the complaint. The prefect of the hostel, who is also a member of the Anti-Ragging committee, submitted a joint undertaking in the meeting given by the new comers of the hostel stating that they were not victim of any type of ragging in the hostel ( Annexure- II). The Member Convenor of the Anti Ragging Committee also issued a notification in the Subansiri Women's hostel on 05.02.2019 asking the students who might be victim of alleged indirect ragging, to report before the Anti ragging Committee in its meeting to be held at 6.00 p.m. on 05.02.2019 (Annexure – III). However, no student from the Subansiri Women's hostel turned up in the meeting. The Senior Warden of the hostel also clarified in the meeting that no order or notification was ever issued asking the students to enter the hostel by 6.30 p.m., as alleged in the complaint. Also, an advisory was issued to participate in the events of the Annual Meet of the University (iversity week) voluntarily and not compulsorily.

The Committee noted that prima facie evidence could not be found in respect of the complaint. The committee found the complaint baseless. However, considering the seriousness of the matter, the Anti-Ragging Committee recommended further on camera individual interaction with the hostel boarders to investigate the matter. In this regard, the meeting constituted a committee with the following members:



WOMEN HOSTEL

B. Inquiry Procedure:

- It was an *in-camera* inquiry
- Duration of inquiry: 3:30 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. on 6/02/2019
- Place of inquiry: Visiting room of Subansiri Hostel
- Language used: English, Hindi and Assamese
- The new boarders and the Prefects and Convenors were requested to be present for the inquiry from 3:30 p.m. onwards at the mentioned place of inquiry
- All the members of the committee were briefed about the nature of the complaint and the procedure of the inquiry by the co-ordinator of the committee
- Each student was invited to voluntarily enter the room individually
- The students were assured that confidentiality will be maintained
- Each boarder was given the opportunity to discuss and speak on the issue.
- Due to lack of time 38 boarders, Prefects and Convenors were inquired.

C. Issues raised in the complaint:

- In-timing of all the new boarders was restricted to 6:30 p.m. during the first few weeks of their admission to the hostel.
- In-timing is restricted again for all new boarders to 6:30 p.m. for the Annual Meet
- The new boarders are compelled to participate in the Annual Meet which is, as alleged by the complainant "indirect ragging"

D. Brief of the statements by the new boarders and the members of the Prefects and Convenors

New Boarders:

1. 31 out of the 33 boarders inquired are participating in one or the other events. The other two boarders, as expressed by them, are not participating from participation because of their ill-health and unavailability during the Meet.

2. 30 out of the 31 have expressed that there is absolutely no compulsion on the part of the Prefects and Convenors in participating in the events registered for at present and that they have participated by choice.
3. 31 out of the 33 boarders have expressed their satisfaction with the working of the Prefects and Convenors in the Hostel and expressed that they are friendly and approachable.
4. The boarders mentioned that the new boarders were given the scope to submit a Medical Certificate in case of their inability to participate in the events. Many of them have decided to not participate due to disinterest.
5. 5 boarders however, expressed that at the initial stage they, or in their opinion some of the boarders felt compelled to participate in the march past either due to the way it was communicated by the Prefects and Convenors or their assumption that this has been the tradition or custom (in their words) of the University.
6. 1 boarder expressed that she felt harassed since participation in every activity was made compulsory to the juniors both, during the initial stage of their admission and for the Annual Meet. The reason of her participation in two of the events in the Annual Meet is to escape from participating in march past which in her view was compulsory for all the new boarders. She was forced to give dance audition despite of her medical condition and is facing severe health issue due to over burden of activities and studies at the same time. She is experiencing changed behavior towards her, and her roommate from the time she started raising her voice on the issue.
7. The boarders mentioned that the Prefects and Convenors has informally restricted the in-timing of the new boarders to 6:30 for the Annual Meet. Most of them have also added that this, however was not compulsory and that it was flexible with only a phone call to the prefect informing their inability to report on time. Also, the non participants were allowed to leave the hostel after the attendance.
8. The boarders expressed that the timing of the Annual Meet and its practice falls during the month of their first test and also the practice goes on for hours and hours in the evening after their classes and some hours in the morning before class which is very stressful for them.
9. According to them, the Annual Meet should be confined precisely to one week during which classes should be suspended rather than a one month long affair.
10. Two of the boarders felt that the act of taking an undertaking from the new boarders stating that they were not compelled to participate in the events "after the complaint was filed" was not appropriate.

*Prefects and Convenors:*

11. The Prefects and Convenors briefed about their approach towards the boarders from the very first meeting in orienting the new boarders about the Annual Meet. The Boarders,

- according to them were encouraged to participate in activities in order to help them come forward in case they were shy.
12. They were liberal with allowing the boarders to not participate in any of the events in case of ill-health or disinterest. The 5 applications for ill-health were then showed to the Inquiry Committee as well.
  13. They accepted that informally they restricted the in-timing of the new boarders to 6:30 for starting the practice on time. The non-participants were allowed to inform the prefect in case of their inability to report on time or can leave after the attendance.

#### E. General Observations

1. At present, most of the boarders inquired are participating in the events voluntarily and enthusiastically
2. The Boarders are happy with Hostel Management and expressed concerns with the impact of the complaint on them. They were in fact surprised on hearing about the complaint. Which shows that the incident even if proved is not rampant within the hostel.
3. The in-timing was restricted locally by Wardens (on the advisory of the Dean, Students Welfare) in the first month of the new session (July-August, 2018) for the safety of the new comers until the General Fresher's Meet organized by the Student Council.
4. The restriction of the in time during the preparation of Annual Meet was found to be a verbal advisory as mentioned by majority of the inquired boarders. The boarders have also added that it was not compulsory and that it was flexible with only a phone call to the Prefect informing their inability to report on time. Also, the non-participants were allowed to leave the hostel after the attendance.
5. Based on the interaction with Freshers, the Committee observed that the Prefects and Convenors in their briefing to the new boarders about the Annual Meet (iversity week as mentioned in the complaint) to be held in the 3rd week of February expressed the desirability of participation of all boarders. Overwhelming majority of the Freshers did not find any semblance of pressure or coercion in the verbal advisory of the Prefects and Convenors. However, a few of them may have perceived the advisory of Prefects and Convenors as kind of pressure.
6. The Boarder claiming of being harassed by the act of the Prefects and Convenors (kindly refer to D. 6.) named a few boarders in her statements. However, the statements of the latter were contradictory to that of hers.
7. There is certainly an issue of concern due to the presumption of a few boarders that the higher authorities cannot be approached in case of a slight feeling of harassment in any way.
8. The timing of the Annual Meet and the first test coincides, which over burdens the students of the university.

9. The procedure of taking the signatures of the boarders in the Undertaking stating that they were not compelled to participate in the Annual Meet was taken after the complaint was filed, this year after the meeting of the DSW with the boarders of the hostel on 4/02/2018 which in the opinion of the committee may have not been necessary.

Recommendations:

1. The Wardens and the General Administration have to be more vigilant during such events.
2. It should be seen that no informal restriction of timings is practiced in the hostel whether strictly followed or not.
3. The students should be encouraged to read the Anti-Ragging Regulation given to them by the University in order to understand what constitutes the act.
4. Voluntary participation of the students should be encouraged rather than the feeling of competitiveness for their respective hostels in order to preserve the spirit of Annual Meet.
5. Although, the tradition of Annual Meet in the University is what adds to the diversity, uniqueness and culture of the University, which has to be continued, this however, can be confined to a week as practiced in other Universities or it should be seen that the test should not coincide or fall somewhere near to the Annual Meet.

On the basis of grievances received from a group of boarders of Kanchanjunga Men's Hostel (KMH) that they were being harassed by their senior students of No 148 of KMH, a meeting of Anti Ragging Committee was held on 11.12.2017 and discussed the matter. Mr. Mriganka Bharali (Roll No. EGI15013), the occupant of the above stated room and Mr. Ritupal Sarma (Roll No.ELB14013), a non-boarder student who used to visit the room quite often, were inquired in the meeting about their involvement in the above misdeed. The meeting not being received convincing answer from the alleged students during inquiry that they were not involved in harassing their juniors, disturbing them in their studies, consuming alcohol and smoking Ganja in the hostel and also on the basis of evidence collected from the room, the Anti Ragging Committee confirmed that this was a case of ragging and the alleged students were directly or indirectly involving in harassing their juniors mentally, disturbing them in their studies, asking them to do certain things which were against their wish and sense of values, besides drinking alcohol and smoking *Ganja* in the hostel.

As per recommendation of the Anti Ragging Committee, the University has imposed following punitive action against them:

1. Mr. Mriganka Bharali and Mr. Ritupal Sarma both be rusticated from the University for one semester i.e. Spring Semester, 2018.
2. Parents of both the students be informed about the misconduct of their wards.

The Vice-Chancellor welcomed the members and called upon the Controller of Examinations to present the agenda of the meeting. The Controller of Examinations informed the members that some boarders of Kanchenjunga Men's Hostel lodged complaint against the boarders of Room No.148 of the same hostel to the Dean, Students' Welfare by e-mail on 25<sup>th</sup> October, 2017 and 10<sup>th</sup> November, 2017. The Controller of Examinations read out the e-mail copies. The complainants did not give their actual names in the e-mail. They requested to make sudden visit to the room no.148, especially after 11:00 pm on Friday and Weekends. They complained that some boarders in that room organised 'wild parties' and disturbed others. The Dean, Students' Welfare received another hand written complaint from six boarders of the Kanchenjunga Men's Hostel where they mentioned that these offenders asked them to bring disposal glasses, water etc for their alcohol drinking purposes and they are facing mental harassment everyday which is affecting in their study also. They also stated that after drinking they make the corridor dirty by throwing garbage, vomiting and even urinating in the corridor itself. These six boarders stated that they saw the following students in that room before the warden visited it on 27.11.2017:

1. Mriganka Bharali (Roll no. EGI15013)
2. Ritupal Sarma (Roll No ELB14013)


The Dean, Students' Welfare informed that he counselled Mr. Mriganka Bharali, the occupant of the Room No.148 immediately after receiving the complaint through first e-mail. He also stated that Dr. Jayanta Vishnu Das, Warden (i/c) of the Kanchenjunga Men's Hostel made sudden visit to that room at 11:00 pm on 27.11.2017 and found alcohol with some glasses in the room. He showed the photographs of the alcohol bottles with glasses on a bench. Dr. Das also seized one apparatus for smoking Ganja with some raw Ganja from the room. When Dr. Das visited there was no one in the room. The Warden (i/c) suspected that the above two students perhaps left the room knowing from some source that he was going to visit the room.

The statements of the boarders and the copy of the e-mail are attached at page 1-4.

The Controller of Examinations informed the members that this matter was initially placed before the Disciplinary Committee meeting. However, the Disciplinary Committee referred it to the Anti-ragging committee to deal with as per the UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in HE institutions, 2009 (amended 2016). The act offender students fall under ragging with following parameters of the UGC Regulations:

- (i) Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do,
- (ii) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher,
- (iii) Any act that affects the mental health and self confidence of a fresher or any other student.

The case was then placed before the house for discussion. As per suggestion of the members, Mr. Mriganka Bharali and Mr. Ritupal Sarma were summoned and they were asked to give explanation and defend against the allegation.





MEETING OF THE ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE HELD AT 3.30 P.M ON  
09.08.2017 IN THE COUNCIL HALL, TEZPUR UNIVERSITY

The Vice Chancellor & Chairman, Anti ragging Committee welcomed the members and called upon the Convenor, ARC and Controller of Examinations to place the agenda of the meeting. The Controller of Examinations informed the members that two students lodged complaints to MHRD through the Anti Ragging Portal on 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2017 that they were ragged by two of senior students. Having received the information from the Supervisor of the MHRD Anti Ragging portal, the Dean, School of Engineering informed the Dean Students Welfare (Chairman of the Anti Ragging Squad) and Registrar about the complaint. The Dean Students' Welfare, Dean, School of Engineering, Registrar (i/c), concerned hostel wardens immediately acted on the issue and on inquiry found that Mr. Ashim Kumar Deo (Roll No. CSB 17048), a boarder of the Kanchanjanga Men's Hostel and Mr. Arup Kar (Roll No. CSB17031), another boarder of Charaideo Men's Hostel lodged the complaints. Both of them are the students of first semester B. Tech programme. The complainants confessed before the committee that they lodged the complaints just to test whether the Anti Ragging Portal worked or not and the complaint was not based on facts. These two students gave their confession in writing also. The Interim Report of the committee along with the statements of the students was sent to the Supervisor of the MHRD Anti Ragging Portal on 6.09.2017(Sunday).

The Controller of Examinations also informed the house that the report of the committee had not been accepted by the Supervisor, MHRD Anti Ragging Portal vide his e-mail dated 09.08.2017 as this was not endorsed by the Anti Ragging Committee (ARC) and directed to take action against them by the Anti Ragging Committee for the false complaint (although all the members of the interim committee were ARC members their official designation(s) were only mentioned). He placed the matter before the house for discussion and decision on the fake complaint of the students.


During the discussion the two complainants, Mr. Ashis Kumar Deo and Mr. Arup Kar were summoned before the committee which heard their statements. The members noted that Mr. Udhav Das is a student of first semester like the complainants and not a senior student and again there is no student named Mr. Sanjeev Gogoi in the CMH (Charaideo Men's Hostel) as stated in the complaint. Hence the names of the senior students and names of the hostel given in the complaint were not found to be valid. The members were convinced that they had lodged the complaints without knowing its implication and they were not ragged by any body. The complainants submitted their confession and regretted for their act.

After a thorough deliberation the meeting came to the conclusion that the complainants Mr. Ashim Kumar Deo and Mr. Arup Kar misused the National Anti Ragging portal and misled the Government and the University authorities and unanimously resolved to impose the following punishment for their offence:

1. Both Mr. Ashim Kumar Deo and Mr. Arup Kar be imposed a fine of Rs 5000/- (Rupees five thousand) each.
2. A stern warning letter be issued to the erring students with a copy to their parents.


## Investigation Report on Ragging Complaint (AS-3503)

1. Both Mr. Ashish Kumar Deo and Mr. Arup Kar are imposed a fine of Rs 5000/- (Rupees five thousand) each. They will deposit the fine in the finance section by 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 and submit a copy of it to the office of the undersigned.
