2. Mr Mrityunjoy Borah shall be prevented from driving bike as he has admitted driving after drinking. His bike and driving licence may be seized immediately.
3. Mr Mrityunjoy Borah shall be rusticated from SCVRMH. However, Warden may allow him to stay provisionally based on his undertakings till his parents come.

The meeting heard from Mr. Afsar Siddique Haque. He confessed that the incident is true. The committee felt that Mr. Haque's behaviour is due to trauma. The meeting after discussion resolved the following:

- (1) The student, Mr. Afsar Siddique Haque be asked to hand over his driving licence and bike to Dr. B. Mandal, Warden, KMH immediately.
- (2) Mr. Haque be handed over to his parents temporarily.
- (3) Mr. Haque be withdrawn from the hostel and kept under parental care.
- (4) He may be allowed hostel accommodation on submission of medical fitness certificate and guardian approval.
- (4) The matter be referred to grievance redressal cell for inquiry and further action.

3. Md Afsar Siddique Haque shall surrender his bike to the Warden of the Hostel/ to Registrar of the University.



- a. As per the report of Mr N K Sarma, Security Officer, TU (F-'A') that two students were caught in the Main Gate while carrying 02(two)bottles of alcohol on 27-02-16 at 10.00 pm. These students confessed (F-'B' & F-'C') their offense in writing. The meeting attended by DSW, ADSW(S), ADSW(C), Warden PMH resolved to take strong action immediately, as they have committed in spite of their parents undertaking sent to University last month (March), that their wards will not be involved in any act of indiscipline. The Heads, both the departments i, e EFL and Commerce were intimated the matter by phone & they also suggested for exemplary action. It is decided that both the students will be handed over to their parents immediately and the case will be referred for further action to higher authority.
- b. Ms Amrita Acharjya (MCM15035) and Ms Nibedita Rajbangshi (EGM 15014) who manhandled themselves and fought each other (reported by Warden and enquired by ADSW(C)(F- 'D' & F-'E') shall be warned and shifted to other Hostel immediately. The matter will be reported to the Students' Disciplinary Committee.
- c. Mr Rikasho Raj Deka (MEB 14001), Mr Sanjeev Dhar (CSB 14010) and Md Esha Gaznavi(outsider, CHB12031) were caught at red handed while cooking inside the room of Mr Rikasho Raj Deka (Room No.-148) of PMH on 02-03-2016 (F- 'F') . Hence, it is recommended that the University should impose following punishment to these students:
- A fine of Rs.3000/- only may be imposed on Mr Rikasho Raj Deka and Mr Sanjeev Dhar.
  - A fine of Rs. 10,000/- only may be imposed on Md Esha Gaznavi. In addition, Mr Gaznavi <sup>maybe</sup> prohibited to enter any hostel of the University.

Welcoming members, Chairman placed the agenda items for discussion in the meeting.

There are 12 cases besides few reporting items to be taken in the meeting. The discussion and decision are given below:

**Case 1 Allegation of Physical assault and leaving out of own rooms**

Mr Sumit Saha (Roll No. ELB13065), a boarder of PMH lodged a complaint to the DSW that two students of KMH, viz., Mr Kunaljit Ojah (Roll No. FPB13003) and Mr Nabajeet Kalita (Roll No. MEB13066) physically assaulted him in the night on 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2016 (and also threatened to assault in future).

Mr Ojah and Mr Kalita denied the allegation of assault in their written statements. However, they accepted their fault of staying in NMH playing video games whole night without any permission of Wardens.

Mr Ojah and Mr Kalita also alleged that Mr Sumit Saha attempted to malign the image of another student Ms Shashwati Hazarika (Roll No. FPB13030). A written complaint was also lodged by Ms Shashwati Hazarika on 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2016 reiterating this allegation against Mr Sumit Saha (Details are at Annexure- I).

From the reports of Wardens and ADSW(S) who visited the site of incident just after the incident, the physical assault could not be confirmed. Absences of Mr Ojah and Mr Kalita from their own Hostel were confirmed from the report of their Warden.

**Decision:**

After deliberating on the case, following, decisions are taken.

- A fine of Rs. 2000/- only is imposed each on Mr Nabajeet Kalita, and Mr Kunaljit Ojah for violating Hostel discipline (Clause.9.3.4) along with stern warning letters not to repeat such indiscipline in future copies of which also to be marked their parents
- Complaint against Mr Sumit Saha by the girl student needs further investigation for which the girls will be asked to provide adequate supporting evidences.

**Case 2 Incident of Bike Accident leading to the death of Mr Nabajit Kaman on 01-04-16**

Mr N K Sarma, Security Officer reported that on 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2016 at about 9.00 pm Mr Nabajit Kaman (CIB13050) a boarder of CMH and Mr Niharjyoti Gogoi (CIB14028) of a boarder of PMH met a bike accident near Doolabari while returning to campus (Annexure -II). Accident was reportedly due to reckless driving. In this accident Mr Kaman scrummed to death while Mr Gogoi was referred to Guwahati for further treatment. It is learnt that these two students were accompanied by some

more students, all of them returning from party. Incidentally, none of these students reported University about the accident/incident. Nature of involvement of the other students is not yet known.

**Decision:**

The Committee express concern and opines to find out true facts which led to the fatal accidents. It is proposed to constitute a committee with the following members to investigate the incident thoroughly and find the all facts for further action.

1. Prof M Barbora, Professor , Dept of EFL (Convenor)
2. Prof S Bhattacharyya , HoD, Dept of ECE
3. Mr S Mahapatra, Asstt Professor, Dept of Energy

The committee will submit the report within three weeks from the date of issue of the notification.

**Case 3:**

**Cases of misbehaviour in the main Gate**

Four research scholars Mr Kuldeep Gupta (Roll No.MBP12003), Mr Debabrata Saikia (Roll No.MBP12102) , Mr Dhurbajyoti Nath (Roll No.MBP13005) of the Dept of MBBT and Mr Jayanta Bhattacharyya (Roll No.MFP12003) of the Dept of Mathematical Sciences were caught in the main gate by security personnel at around 9.00 pm on 7<sup>th</sup> April, 2016 reportedly in a drunken state. After initial denial, all the students admitted their faults later through written apology letter (Annexure-III). While confessing they also assured not to repeat such act in future.

**Decision:**

Considering the confession and apologetic behaviour, following actions are recommended:

- a. Stern warning letter to all of the three students, viz., Mr Kuldeep Gupta, Mr Debabrata Saikia, Mr Dhurbajyoti Nath and Mr Jayanta Bhattacharyya with copies marked to their parents
- b. The students be expelled from the University, if found to involve in any act of indiscipline in future.

**Case 4:**

**Cases of alcohol**

- (I) Mr Prantik Das (Roll No. MCI15016), a boarder of NMH was caught red handed by Security Staff while attempting to carry alcohol bottles through main gate at about 7.50 pm on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2016 (Annexure IV).
- (II) Mr Sudarshan Saikia (Roll No.CIB14009) and Mr Arnab Chakravarty (Roll No. CIB14005) were caught red handed in the main gate by security personal at about 7.30 pm on 21 May, 2016 while carrying alcohol bottles with them (Annexure V).
- (III) Ms Murchanna Lopamudra (Roll No EGL14017) was caught red handed while carrying alcohol bottles by lady security staff on 21 May, 2016 (Annexure VI)
- (IV) The security officer reported that Mr Dipankar Chetry (Roll No.BBI12003) and Mr Saptayan Dey (Roll No.ELB12025), met an accident due to reckless driving in alcoholic state inside the campus on 6<sup>th</sup> Jan, 2016 at about 1.00 am. Mr Dey who was driving the bike lost his three teeth (Annexure VII)
- (V) Mr Michael Daimari (Roll No. CSM14009), Mr Kangkan Ojah (Roll No.MEB13034), Mr Pritom Sonowal (EEB14016) and Mr Bijoy Das (CSM14017) were caught in CMH 241 (Belong to Mr Pritom Sonowal and Mr Bijoy Das) with a bottle of alcohol on 24 April, 2016 at 12:30 am during sudden visit by DSW, ADSW and Warden. The students confessed that three of them,

except Mr Das, intended to consume alcohol (Annexure VIII). Numbers of empty bottles were also found outside the window of the room.

**Decision:**

The committee felt that all alcohol related cases should be sternly dealt with so as to deter students against rampant consumption of Alcohol. Importance of this is realised so as to prevail conducive academic environment in the campus. While deliberating on the above cases, some penalties are recommended uniformly to all the above mentioned students. While taking the case of Mr Bijoy Das, who reportedly did not drink, the committee viewed that agreeing to host alcohol party in his room, he violated the Hostel discipline and therefore he is also equally guilty. The penalties recommended for all the students mentioned above are:

- a) Stern warning letter be issued to the students with copies of the letters to their parents and
- b) A fine of Rs. 5,000/- be imposed to each of them

**Case 5**

**Security matter of the Hostel:**

Ms Shilpa Bhuyan (Roll No. CST14006) a boarder of PMCWH reported at 1.00 am on 15 May, 2016 that a person was peeping in her room through ventilator. Initially she doubted Mr Samarjit Gogoi (Roll No ENE14011) as that person. Later Ms Bhuyan changed her statement that it was nothing but illusion (Annexure IX). The Wardens of the hostel wants further investigation of the matter to find out the facts.

**Decision:**

The Disciplinary Committee expressed concerned about the fatal accident and emphasis to bring out the fact genuinely. The report which was based on the written statements of three students suspected to be involved in the accident needs a revision. Prof S C Deka, Dept and Dr R K Duary are recommended to induct as the new members of the fact finding committee to review the report and submit it at the earliest possible. .

**Misbehaving with Staff member by Boarder**

Mr Sourav Jyoti Borah, Caretaker, KMH lodged a complaint against a boarder Md Akuib Ali Hazarika (Roll No ELB12003) for misbehaving him during duty hours (Annexure-XI )

**Decision:**

Md Akuib Ali Hazarika be asked to apologise with Mr Borah in presence of DSW.





All members of the Students Disciplinary Committee viewed the cases very seriously and expressed concern to recommend stern action to prevent any alcohol related incidents viz., consumption of alcohol, attempts to consume alcohol and providing space to consume alcohol. As per the recommendation of the Student's Disciplinary Committee, following penalties are imposed on each of the above offenders:

- a) Stern warning letter shall be issued to all the offending students with copies of the letters to their parents
  - b) A fine of Rs. 5,000/- shall be imposed to each of them



The meeting discussed the incidence reported by Anti Ragging Sub Committee about consumption of alcohol by 9 (Nine) students in the room PMH 360 at night (11:45 pm) on 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2016.

The incident:

The sub-committee, consisting of Prof. S.K. Dutta, Dr. Arindam Karmakar and Dr Sumesh SS, in their sudden visit to the Hostel found suspicious assembling of nine students in the said room. When asked about the purpose of their meeting in such an unusual time, students could not reply convincingly. On getting information, ADSW and Security Officer also rushed to the spot. The students attempted to throw empty alcohol bottles through the window in presence of the committee, which were recovered from the window pan. A bowl of cooked chicken was also recovered from the room. The committee reported the matter along with confess letter of the students (listed below) to DSW (Enclosure A).

The Disciplinary Committee wished to interrogate the accused and called them accordingly. Students confessed that they brought alcohol from town and drank alcohol in the hostel. There were differences of their confession, probably in an attempt to hide the facts. According to them, they brought alcohol (some said 2 bottles, other said 5 bottles) from Tezpur and carried in bags while coming through ASTC bus with an individual contribution of Rs. 80/- per head. There was also contradiction of their initial statement while stating that Mr Partha Pratim Sonowal only accompanied them without consuming alcohol.

the meeting also observed that Mr. Pallab Das who is a TUSC member has also involved in such act of indiscipline.

Mr. Partha Pratim Sonowal, who came from KMH to attend the party, mentioned his surname name as "Chetia" in original confession letter, probably to hide his identity.

It is also reported that parents of all the accused students provided undertaking (copy enclosed), in connection with earlier indiscipline activities, assuring not to repeat in future.

Members of the Students Disciplinary Committee expressed their serious concern about the incident and urged to recommend exemplary action.

**Resolution:**

By analysing the attitude and behaviour of the students, **the committee recommends that they shall be rusticated from the hostel and University for a period of at least two semesters.**

The TUSC representative shall be suspended from his post with immediate effect.

On the other hand, one of the students' representatives pleaded for imposition of softer penalty such as imposition of a fine of appropriate amount with social service in library or any other place, warning letter with a copy to their parents etc. Majority of the members are not convinced with such suggestion considering repeated attempts of a section of students to disturb the academic environment.

All above students have been asked to inform their parents to come to the University and learn the decision of the University and act accordingly.



The committee discussed the joint report of the Warden, Associate Warden, Prefects, Asstt. Prefects and in charge of Hostel discipline of Subansiri Women Hostel on the incident of alcohol drinking by three students of the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester MBA programme in the mid night of 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2016 ( Copy enclosed, F-1).

During discussion the Dean, Mgt Sc and Head, Department of Business Administration informed the house that these students were warned a couple of days ago and asked not indulge themselves into any act of indiscipline. However, the students did not care it and got involved such act of indiscipline.

After thorough discussion on the issue and going through their confession statement (Copy enclosed, F-2) the meeting recommended the following:

1. The three students, viz, Ms. Mrinmoy Deb, Ms. Lisa Baruah and Ms. Jenita Burhagohain be rusticated from the hostel for one semester with stern warning letter
2. Parents of these boarders be informed about the misdeed committed by their wards and action imposed on them.

**Case I: Consumption and carrying alcohol by two students on 29.8.2016**

The Security Officer of the University reported that two students, viz, (1) Mr Saikot Sarkar (1<sup>st</sup> semester M. Tech in FET programmes) and (2) Mr. Abhisek Kakoti (1<sup>st</sup> semester Int. M. Com) were caught at about 7.30 p.m. on 29.8.2016 while attempting to enter through main gate in a heavily drunken state in motorcycle and carrying one bottle of alcohol. After initial denial to provide written statement about their act of indiscipline, DSW, Warden, KMH and Head of the Department of FET and One Faculty from the Department of Commerce had to intervene to get their written confessions. Knowing the case, VC directed to (a) inform the parents of both the students, (b) hand over Mr. Abhisek Kakoti to parents till a final decision is taken, (c) debar both the students from attending classes till a final decision is taken and (d) convene students disciplinary committee meeting to take the case. The directives are followed and implemented as intermediate measures.

Detailed reports of the Security Officer along with the statement of the students are placed at F- 1. The members of the Students Disciplinary Committee expressed their serious concern on such behaviour of the newly admitted students. It is further learnt that Mr Saikot Sarkar, who has joined M Tech (FET) programme in this session after serving some organization earlier, behaves improperly in the Hostel while dealing with other boarders. It appears from the verbal and written statements the Mr Sarkar took lead of the incident and therefore, his penalty should be more than Mr Kakoti. Recommendations are as below.

Decision:

→ Referred  
→ Fresh Semester

1. Mr. Saikot Sarkar shall be rusticated from the hostel for the remaining period of his study.
2. Mr. Abhisek Kakoti shall be expelled from the hostel for two semesters including the current semester.
3. Both of Mr Sarkar and Kakoti must improve their behaviour and academic record failing which they shall be denied their Character certificate by Tezpur University.
4. They shall be put under Conduct Probation for Two Semesters.

**Case II: Appeal of Mr. Bijoy Das (Roll No. CSM14017) for exemption of fine imposed to him due to alcohol consumption**

Mr. Bijoy Das was imposed a fine of Rs 5000/- along with other three boarders for a case on consumption of alcohol in CMH on 24 April, 2016 vide Office order dated 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2016. Mr. Das requested to reduce his fine up to Rs 500/= due his financial problem (application at F-2).

Decision:

1. Mr. Das shall be relaxed to pay the fine amount in instalment. Further, Hostel Warden may be communicated to provide some suitable jobs to Mr Das, if possible, so that Mr Das can earn to pay the fine amount.

**Case III: Alcohol consumption by a group of passed out and one continuing students in KMH on 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2016**

A group comprising of (a) passed out TU students (b) passed out DU students and (c) one continuing TU student were found indulged in consumption of alcohol at about 23.10 p.m. in the KMH. The members of the group are:

All the passed out and continuing students, except sl no. 6, were given permission to stay in the hostel up to 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2016 facilitating them to appear for the NET. Detailed report of the Security Office is placed at F-3.

University provided accommodation to the TU passed out and continuing students during summer recess to help them to prepare and appear in the UGC NET. However, they misused the facility and violated hostel rules. Further, they invited outsider for indiscipline activities in the hostel. The members expressed concern and recommended the following:

**Decision:**

1. Penalty of Rs 20,000/- be imposed to all, except sl.6. Degree Certificate of the Students shall be denied if they fail to pay fine within two months from the issue of the notification.
2. The matter of Mr. Ranjan Sarma shall be referred to the Vice-Chancellor of the Dibrugarh University for action at their end.

**Case IV: Appeal of Dr. Brijesh Srivastava to relieve him from the Fact finding Committee constituted to find out the fact on the incident leading to death of Mr. Saidul Ali**

A committee with Dr. Brijesh Srivastava as Chairperson was constituted to find out the fact of the accident occurred on 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2015 where Md. Saidul Ali, a students of B.Tech FET succumbed to death. The report of the committee was placed before the Disciplinary committee held on 30.05.2016. The Disciplinary committee, not satisfied with the report of the fact finding committee, recommended to review the report and suggested to induct Prof. S.C. Deka and Dr. R.K. Duary as new members in the committee. As per decision of the Disciplinary Committee, Dr. Brijesh Srivastava was requested to review the report to bring out the fact clearly. However, Dr. Srivastava has requested to relieve him from the committee vide his letter-dated 26. 7. 2016 (F- 4). The matter was placed before the meeting for discussion and decision.

**Decision:**

Considering the seriousness of the issue, the members wished to bring the truth out. Prof. S.C. Deka shall be appointed as Chairperson of the fact finding committee in place of Dr. Brijesh Srivastava with a request to submit the revised report at the earliest. Members of the committee will remain as per earlier decision.

Meeting ended with Vote of thanks to and from the chair.

They also misused the infrastructure of the University like WiFi, electricity etc. watching the cricket during odd hours and disturbed study/liveable environment of the room. The meeting recommended the following:

1. Mr Sumit Saurabh and Mr Kankan Malakar shall be rusticated from the hostel for two semesters.

2. Conduct probation for two semesters to all the three students
3. Stern warning letter shall be issued to abstain from such activities in future with intimation to their parents.
4. Stern warning letter shall be issued to Md. Afsar Sadique Haque to comply with the office order issued earlier failing which he will be debarred from appearing the semester end examinations.

**Case: I** Report of the Fact Finding Committee on the accident leading to death of Mr Nabajit Kaman

A fact finding committee with Prof M Borbora, Professor, Dept of EFL was constituted to find out the fact of the bike accident occurred near Doolabari on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016, leading to death of Mr Nabajit Kaman (CIB13050) a boarder of CMH and student of B Tech in Civil Engineering while returned into campus.

There were two students on the bike viz., Mr Nabajit Kaman and Mr Niharjyoti Gogoi (Roll CIB14028 also a B Tech in Civil Engineering student). There were unconfirmed reports that accident occurred due to consumption of alcohol by a group of students and reckless driving of bike during return trip to University. Involvement of some more students was also reported earlier. The fact finding committee examined documents and collected written statements from the students whose names were known as involved in the case. Students agreed that they went to eat to Restaurant outside and denied alcohol consumption. The report of the committee is placed at Annexure I.

**Resolution:** The report of the fact finding committee is found to produce no new fact and thus remain inconclusive with reference to the cause of the fatal accident. Students Disciplinary Committee decided to forward it to the Vice Chancellor for his perusal and consideration.

**Case: II** Bicycle Sold without Owner's knowledge

It is reported that Mr Pratik Dixit (Roll CSB14047) a student of 5<sup>th</sup> semester B Tech in CSE and boarder of KMH sold the bicycle belonging to Mr Jnan Jyoti Deka (Roll FPB13019) on 12-08-2016 to the cycle store outside the main gate without information to the owner. Mr Deka, who earlier reported to the Security officer about his lost bicycle, noticed his lost cycle at the said cycle store on 14-09-2016 and immediately reported it to the Security Officer. Mr Dixit admitted his offence and returned the bicycle to Mr Deka, the owner (Details at Annexure-II).

**Resolution:** After a threadbare discussion, following decisions are taken:

Conduct probation for two semesters to Mr Pratik Dixit and Stern warning letter with intimation to his parents

Further, the meeting suggested Warden of KMH to find out probable fact which could lead to such behaviour of Mr Dixit and arrange required counselling.

**Case: III** Report of the accident of a car with a bike on the campus on 26-08-2016.

An accident between the car driven by Prof S Barua, Dept of MBBT and a bike driven by Mr Nilutpal Baruah (Roll CIB15018) a boarder of NMH took place at T-Junction (near Essential) at about 4.20 pm on 26-08-2016 which was reported by Security Officer (Details are placed at Annexure -III). From the documents produced by Security Officer, it is observed that Mr Nilutpal Baruah was driving a bike belonging to Md Asif Ahmed (Roll CIB16021, B Tech in Civil Engineering) and Mr Baruah didn't have driving license with him

**Resolution:** The meeting resolved that a stern warning letter be issued to Mr Nilutpal Baruah (for unauthorised driving) and Md Asif Ahmed (for transferring bike to a person without Driving Licence) with intimation to their parents.

**Case: IV** Application of Mr Ritupal Sarma (Roll No.ELB14013) for reduction of disciplinary action and re-admission into Hostel.

Mr Ritupal Sarma was debarred for taking Hostel admission for the rest of his study in this University vide Memo No. TU/DSW/DC/14/12-10/256-A dt.18-12-2015 for his reckless driving of motorbike in inebriated condition inside the campus. Mr Sarma obeyed the disciplinary action and now staying outside. Mr Sarma has requested for Hostel accommodation on the campus stating his difficulties to stay outside (Annexure-IV).

**Resolution:** The meeting resolved that appeal of Mr Ritupal Sarma be considered based on the report of the Department on his academic performance and conduct. Accordingly, it is decided that the Head, Dept of ECE be requested to provide report on academic performance and conduct of Mr Ritupal Sarma to be placed in the next meeting for a decision.

**Case: V** Application of five boarders for reduction of their penalty imposed for alcohol consumption in KMH when they were provided temporary accommodation for appearing in UGC-NET Examination. *boozing*

The following students were imposed fine (amount as shown against their names) for consumption of alcohol in the Hostel (vide Memo No.TU/DSW/Disc/16-F.17/341-A, dt. 06-09-2016). Now, the students have requested to reduce the amount stating that the imposed amount becomes heavier for them (Details are placed at Annexure-V).

- i. Mr Bhriagu Raj Boro (MA, Sociology passed out with a fine of Rs. 20,000/=)
- ii. Mr Gyanendra Deka (MA, Sociology passed out with a fine of Rs. 20,000/=)
- iii. Mr Banjit Nath (MA, Sociology passed out with a fine of Rs. 20,000/=)
- iv. Mr Parag Ch Deka. (MA, Linguistics passed out with a fine of Rs. 20,000/=)
- v. Mr Bikas Bhattacharya (Roll No. EGB14001 continuing student with a fine of Rs. 10,000/=)

After discussing the matter the Committee resolved the following.

**Resolution:** The amount of the fine may be reduced and be imposed Rs.5,000/- each instead of Rs.20,000/-.

**Case: VI:** Carrying of alcohol by two boarders of KMH to the campus on 06-09-2016.

The Security Officer reported that Mr Mriganka Nath (Roll FPB16004) and Mr Gaurav Kumar (Roll FPB16027) both First Semester Students from the Department of FET, were caught in the main gate by security guards with two beer bottles which they were bringing from outside to the campus. Details are placed at Annexure -VI.

**Resolution:** The Committee expressed serious concern on the acts of the fresher students and recommended the following penalties:

Penalty of Rs. 5,000/- each along and stern warning letters with intimation to their parents.
