MAINTENANCE OF WATER BODIES AND DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM IN CAMPUS

The 262-acre campus of Tezpur University is located amidst lush green natural beauty. Vast natural setting of green campus bestows a visual treat indicating an eco-friendly culture unique to the University.

There are three water bodies that are maintained regularly on a monthly basis. The water bodies are fed by rainfall and artificial recharging. This is done through the back-wash water of the swimming pool which is fed to the waterbodies after due treatment. Two drains drawing water from the campus mainly from the hostels and residential areas are also fed to the water body after treatment.

The water bodies serve as habitat for number of wild and semi-wild water birds such as egrets, whistling ducks or tree ducks, white-breasted water-hen, snake neck water birds and others. These water bodies along with the associated plants in the surrounding areas are also home to dragonflies, butterflies, semi-aquatic rodent and reptiles. These water bodies are also home to several variety of fishes.

A Fishery Management Committee is also constituted for a term of three years to see the overall day-to-day running and maintenance of the Ponds (fisheries) of the University.

The horticulture section of the University has made an effort in beautifying the surrounding of the water bodies with flowers. The surrounding of the water body opposite the Vice Chancellor's Residence, locally named as 'Niribili' is also installed with benches for the retreat of students and employees after their day-to-day academic activities.
