Issues Faced (in general):

I. Academic issues pertaining to the classroom lectures.

Action Taken: The students are encouraged to attend the remedial classes for the respective courses in order to address the difficulties faced therein. The mentors may inform the respective course instructors regarding any such issue, in case the student is hesitant to discuss the same with the course instructors.

II. Adjustment issues regarding staying in the hostel.

Action Taken: The students are encouraged to raise such issues with the Warden. If the issues are of serious nature, the HoD intervenes by bringing the matter to the purview of the DSW.

III. Covid-19 Lockdown and home stay. These ranged from:

- a. Stress related to Covid-19 Pandemic, Online classes and Exams.
- b. Network, internet bandwidth issues that hamper live online classroom lectures.
- c. Lack of a conducive academic environment at home/domestic issues.

Action Taken:

a) All mentors provided counseling sessions to their respective mentees to address their mental health during the Lockdown. These included allaying their fears regarding exam process and future career prospects. They were advised to follow the Covid-19 protocols to prevent infection.

b) The Department has created a repository of pre-recorded lectures that have been shared with students. Also the online classes are recorded and the recordings are shared with students on demand.

c) The mentors have not been able to address this particular issue very effectively. Nevertheless they have provided whatever support possible in terms of regularly talking to the students and motivating them to carry on with their academic pursuit despite the difficulties faced.
