Subject : Acceptance of Proposal for Establishment Computer Centre - regarding.

Sir,

With reference to request of the University for Establishment of Computer Centre vide letter No.TU/VC/CC/96/11588 dated 17.01.1996 on the above subject, I am directed to say that proposal of the University was considered by the Standing Committee on computer education and development and on its recommendations the commission has accepted the proposal for creating some computer facilities in the University, I am therefore directed to convey the approval of the commission to provide Rs.20,00,000/-(Rupees twenty lakhs only) to the University for creating some computer facilities of level - I Computer Centre.

2) The Commission will also reimburse recurring grant like maintenance of computers, stationary/consumables, staff salary for a period of five years as per existing guidelines for level - I Computer Centre.

3) The recurring assistance is provided by the UGC as below :-

(1) Salary of posts is provided as per actuals for a period of five years beginning from the year in which the system has been installed or from the year in which first post has been filled up whichever is later. The posts approved under Level-I Computer Centre are as under :

(11) Maintenance of the computer system is provided at the rate at which maintenance contract has been given by the university subject to a maximum of 8% of the hardware cost. Maintenance in the first year is provided free by the supplier. Therefore, UGC assistance is provided from the second year after installation of the system, for a period of four years.

(111) Rs.1 lakh per year for consumables software and books for a period of five years.

4) This approval is valid for one year from the date of the approval. If the grant is not utilised within a year, the approval letter shall stand cancelled.

5) Purchase of Hardware ^{/Software} items may be finalised as per prescribed rules of the University. Hardware/Software items suggested by the Standing Committee have been listed in Annexure-II.

6) Hardware items finally selected may be intimated to the Commission before placing orders.

7) I am also directed to convey the sanction of the University Grants Commission to the payment of an 'on account' grant of Rs.18,00,000/- (Rupees Eighteen lakhs only) to the University as first instalment out of the above said approved grant of Rs.20,00,000/-.

8) The grant is subject to the terms and conditions as stated above in addition to the general conditions of the 8th plan scheme of the commission.

9) The University should convey the acceptance of the terms and conditions of grant-in-aid and send the bill for Rs.18,00,000/- in form T.R. 42 duly filled in and signed within a period of 3 months of the date of issue of this sanction order.

10) The sanction shall be valid for payment during the financial year 96-97 Utilization Certificate duly supported by audited statement of expenditure should be furnished to the UGC at the earliest possible for total grant received by the University for establishment of Computer Centre.

11) The University should maintain subsidiary accounts of grant-in-aid.

12) The account of University shall be subject to the inspection by Officers of the UGC.

13) While sending proposal for release of the next instalment of grant under the above scheme, the University should send the audited statement of expenditure, Utilisation Certificate, Progress Report and Asset Certificates in the usual proforma pending receipt of which no further grant shall be sanctioned.

14) The University shall also send the Installation and working report of the upgraded computer system on receipt of which balance admissible grant will be released to the University.

15) The University should fully implement the official language policy of the Union Govt. and that it shall fully comply with the official language act, 1963 and official language (use for the official purpose of the Union) Rules, 1976, etc.

16) The University shall ensure effective implementation of policies of Govt. of India relating to SC/ST students and teachers in regard to the UGC programmes. In the case of non-teaching staff, the policy of the Central Govt. in the case of Central Universities and of the State Govt. in the case of State Universities shall be implemented.

17) The University shall maintain an inventory of permanent or semi-permanent assets created/acquired wholly or mainly out of the grants by the UGC in the prescribed performa. The inventory should be kept up dated and a certificate to this effect should be furnished alongwith the utilization certificate.

18) A copy of the guideline is enclosed herewith.





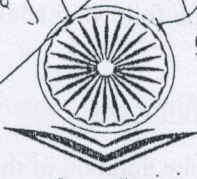

This has reference to the proposal submitted by the Department of Electronics, Tezpur University, Napaam for seeking support for M.Tech in Bio Electronics under the Innovative Programme - Teaching & Research in Interdisciplinary & Emerging Areas.

2. The proposal was presented by Departmental representatives before an Expert Committee in March, 2004. After discussing with Departmental representatives and very careful examination of the proposal of the Department of Electronics, the Committee has selected and recommended the department for induction and support under the Programme. The UGC has accepted the recommendations of the expert committee for support the proposal for starting M.Tech in Bio Electronics at the Department of Electronics under the above programme. Accordingly, I am directed to convey the approval of the UGC to provide the following financial assistance to the Tezpur University, Napaam, to the above mentioned course for a period of five (5) years i.e. 1.4.2004 to 31.3.2009 with a student intake of 15.

The details of the item-wise grants approved above are as given in the ANNEXURE-I.

The programme will be effective from 1st April, 2004.

3. ADDITIONAL GRANTS

The UGC may also consider the following additional grants subject to the availability of funds under the programme :

Maintenance grant for the equipment

The financial assistance is for the duration of the plan period or as approved by the Commission. The Commission may provide maintenance grant on rate contract basis upto 5% of the equipment cost for the remaining period of the programme after the guarantee/warranty period is over. The proof of the warranty /guarantee is to be supplied in such case. After the completion of the terms, the University/Institute/College will have to assume responsibility for maintenance of the equipment purchased under this programme.

✓ Over Head Charges

The UGC may provide additional grant to the tune of 10% (ten per cent) of the total allocation (Non-recurring and Recurring) {except staff salary} approved to a department under the Programme subject to a maximum of Rs.2.00.lakhs {Rupees two lakhs only} or the actual expenditure whichever is less towards water, electricity and telephone, Fax, e-mail (Only equipment cost of these items. Recurring cost of these items will have to be met by the University/Institute/College for the entire period of the programme or less as the case may be.

4. The academic programmes in the universities / colleges are expected to be innovative. Accordingly, the University Grants Commission has been implementing a scheme for Innovative Programmes – Teaching & Research in Interdisciplinary in Emerging Areas during the Xth Plan period. The objectives to identify institutions, scholars and support them are (i) to develop specialised courses at Under-graduate and Post-graduate levels in emerging areas and (ii) accommodate new ideas and innovative proposals to influence teaching, research, academic excellence, societal development and to consider steps to encourage, promote scientific and technological applications for the benefit of the society. Hence, the programme lays emphasis on selection of innovative ideas with a field orientation preferably interdisciplinary in nature.

5. The general terms and conditions as applicable from time to time for UGC assistance and are also applicable to this programme.

✓ 6. The first instalment of grant is being sanctioned separately. However, the grant sanctioned can be utilized only after submission of the following documents :-

✓ a. The letter of acceptance of the terms & conditions of the grants of the programme by the Registrar of the University / Principal of the College and the Coordinator of the programme.

✓ b. A copy of the approval of the University bodies (Executive Council, Academic Council and Board of Studies) to start the course as approved by the UGC in the University /College /Institute.

✓ c. An assurance from the University/College/Institute that the approved course will continue after the UGC assistance to the programme ceases.

✓ d. The name of the nodal Department and Coordinator of the programme may be intimated to the UGC.

✓ e. The course curricula has to be revised as per interactions during the presentation to the Committee and the revised curricula may please be sent to the UGC.

- f. ✓ A separate account for the grant under the programme is essential to be maintained with intimation to the UGC.
- g. ✓ The Coordinator should have the freedom to place orders and act as per directions of the purchase committee constituted by the institution for the purpose as per guidelines.
- h. The further conditions and directives to implement the programme are given in the guidelines also.
- i. The university / college / institute may also intimate:
 - i) the name of the competent officer who will receive the grant on behalf of the university / college / institute for the programme with full address.
 - ii) the name of the Bank and account number (for the programme) with detailed address may be submitted/intimated to the UGC.
 - iii) the name of the Statutory Auditors of the university / college / institute with their full address
- 7. The UGC expect that for better Coordination and accountability for successfully implementation of the programme, the Coordinator may continue the full term of the programme.
- 8. The nodal Department should act as a Resource Center and disseminate the programmes developed by it to nearby universities / colleges / Institutes particularly to the institutions located at nearby remote places.
- 9. ✓ The university / institute / college and the Department concerned will take expeditious action to implement the programme immediately. The university / institution will also extend operational flexibility to the programme.
- 10. ✓ The university / State Government will takeover the recurring liability of the staff sanctioned, if any, under the programme and other recurring liabilities after the UGC assistance to the programme ceases on completion of the approved duration.
- 11. Since the posts approved, if any, under this programme are not Plan posts, the financial liabilities of the UGC will be from their date of appointment under the programme upto the date of completion of the programme duration from the effective date as notified and accepted by the UGC.
- 12. ✓ Posts approved, if any, under the programme and are lying vacant upto the date of completion of the programme duration, the approval of the UGC for those vacant posts may be treated as lapsed.
- 13. The grant for the staff approved, if any, and appointed under the programme will be released after the receipt of the concurrence of the State Government / assurance of the university / institutions with source of payment of staff salary and details of the recommendations of the Selection Committee, bio-data, copy of joining report of the candidate selected, basic pay and other allowances approved for them.
- 14. ✓ The UGC will not pay for the ad hoc / temporary appointments made, if any, against the regular posts approved under the programme.


15. The university / institute will open a separate account for the programme and all interests earned by the university / institute by investment of funds sanctioned and paid by the UGC will be credited to the programme. The interest earned may be shown in the annual statement of expenditure and the amount cannot be utilized without prior approval of the UGC.
16. The grants allocated for approved recurring items may be utilized in the same year for which the grants was released.
17. The expenditure on approved recurring items should be restricted to the ceiling approved per annum for each item. No additional grant will be paid for excess expenditure.
18. If it is absolutely necessary, re-appropriation of funds within 'Recurring' heads may be considered by the UGC on receipt of a specific proposal with adequate justifications for the proposed re -appropriation. No re-appropriation should be made without prior approval of the UGC.
19. Expenditure incurred or any amount deducted from sanctioned amount by the university / institute for any other purposes other than the items approved for implementing the programme will not be acceptable to the Commission.
20. The Organisation shall further implement the Official Language of the Policy of the Union Government, i.e. comply with the "Official Language Act, 1963. and "Official Language (use for the official purpose of the Union Rules), 1976" etc.
21. The University / Institute shall take all possible measures to ensure effective implementation of policies of Govt. of India relating to SC/ST candidates and teachers in regard to the UGC programmes. In the case of non-teaching staff, the policies of the Central Government in respect of Central Universities and of the State Government in respect of State Universities shall be implemented.
22. The second and subsequent instalment of grant will be considered only on receipt of the following information in the prescribed form in respect of the previous instalment of grants:
 - i) year-wise(As per the effective date intimated and noted by the UGC) statement of actual expenditure incurred on each item approved for implementing the programme in the prescribed form, duly signed by the Registrar / Principal and Coordinator.
 - ii) Utilization certificate in the prescribed form, duly signed by the Registrar / Principal and Coordinator .
 - iii) Annual progress report from the effective date of the programme in the prescribed form
23. The statement of accounts, duly audited by the statutory Auditors of the university/college/institute may be submitted to the UGC as early as the accounts are audited.
24. The approval of the above course is subject to the condition that the above course should not be self-financing.

25. In case where university / institute / college is unable to obey and reasonably complied with the guidelines and the programme is not implemented within six months from the date of approval/first sanction/effective date as noted by the UGC, serious action may be taken and the grants will be withheld or the programme may be withdrawn with the refund of sanctioned amount with interest.

Approval of this grant shall be valid subject to Establishment of Special Cell for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes by the university during current financial year strictly according to the guidelines of the scheme. You are requested to go through these guidelines carefully for compliance while implementing this scheme.
4. The Commission's assistance under this scheme will be available to your University for the X Plan period only i.e. from the date of receipt of this letter by the university upto the end of the X Plan period. The continuation after first year would be based on the performance of the Institution in the current year under the scheme. The Expenditure over and above of the approved amount will not be treated as admissible expenditure. Such inadmissible expenditure shall be borne by the university from its own resources.
5. The University will provide infrastructure facilities such as furniture facilities and other necessary required facilities from its own resources for Establishment of Special Cell for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
6. To enable your university to implement this program an 'on account' grant of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees one lakh fifty thousand only) is being released to the university separately. Grants for the subsequent financial year will be reimbursed only on receipt of statement of expenditure, utilization certificate and annual progress report for the initial grant in the prescribed formats as given in the guidelines.

Dear Prof. Deka,

Kindly recall that we had a meeting with you on 16th June, 2006 to consider the revised plan proposals submitted by your university within plan allocation made by the Commission for the year 2006-07.

2. Based on the priorities indicated by you and suggestions made in the meetings held in the MHRD and in UGC, the Commission has approved the revised plan for utilization of allocated amount of Rs.22.00 crores as per details given in Annexure-I.

3. As was decided in the meeting, any committed liabilities under Xth Plan shall be accommodated within revised plan allocation for 2006-07.

4. The requirement of your university for the Faculty of Engineering was also discussed in the meeting and it was decided that University may initiate the establishment of Faculty of Engineering on the basis of estimate prepared by the Ed.CIL and subsequently as modified / approved by Academic Council / Executive Council of the University. The funds required for this faculty, to start with, may be accommodated under the initial allocation of Rs.5.00 crores already provided to your university and excess may be booked under the overall funds available with the University. However, the additional funds will be provided, later, on reviewing of the utilisation of funds position of the University. The approval of teaching and non-teaching/technical positions for this faculty is enclosed in Annexure-II. Further, the posts sanctioned now in the Xth Plan (Annexure - II) shall be treated as first charge of the XIth Plan till it comes to end by 31st March, 2012.

5. Further to what we discussed in the meeting, I wish to draw your attention to a communication dated 9.5.2006 received from MHRD asking UGC "not to release the financial assistance under the plan funds for the 2nd quarter without obtaining a certification from each Central University to the effect that every vacancy in respect of post under direct recruitment/promotion by way of backlog reserved for SCs and STs have been duly advertised and filled". You are, therefore, requested to kindly identify the backlog vacancies to the extent of 22½% for SC and ST and advertise them to be filled up from among these categories. Needless to mention, UGC, in compliance of the Government of India's instructions, shall not be in position to release further instalments unless the instructions of Government of India are complied with in letter and spirit and UGC is informed of accordingly.

6. The Commission has already released one-third of allocated plan grant of your university for the year 2006-07 and as such, you are required to ensure that the utilization certificate of grants received by your university is submitted to the UGC on time so as to enable UGC to consider release of next instalment of course after meeting the stipulation made under para-5 above. As informed earlier, a flow chart for monthly plan expenditure may be conveyed to us in compliance of MHRD instructions.

7. Wishing you the best of utilization of funds.





Sir,

I am directed to say that the competent authority has approved the '**non-plan**' scheme for extending financial assistance to the Administrative Training Institutes (ATIs) and/or other training institutes in States for operation of a Faculty/Centre of Disaster Management for a five year period from 2007-08 to 2011-12, involving a total expenditure not exceeding Rs.25 crore (Rupees twenty five crore), as per the break-up given below :-

2. The scheme will be implemented by the **National Institute of Disaster Management(NIDM)** in accordance with the guidelines enclosed at **Annexure-I**. Funds for the purpose will be provided to NIDM annually; within the year-wise limits indicated in para 1 above, based on the progress of utilization of the assistance by the ATIs/other training institutes in previous year(s).
3. The ATIs/other training institutes which had earlier been identified in consultation with the State Governments (**Annexure-II**) for availing assistance for operation of a Faculty/Centre of Disaster Management under the Central Sector Plan Scheme on National Disaster Management Programme (which had been under implementation till the end of the financial year 2006-07) would continue to be eligible to receive financial assistance from NIDM under the new scheme. The State Governments concerned may, however, propose deletion/addition/ substitution of the institutes identified for the purpose of availing such assistance under the earlier scheme. The UT Governments/ Administrations which have so far not identified any training institute for operation of a Faculty/Centre of Disaster Management can also take benefit of the Scheme by putting in place the necessary institutional mechanism for training in disaster management.
4. Financial Assistance under the Scheme may be released by NIDM only after ensuring that the ATI/training institute concerned has utilized the funds already released in accordance with the provisions contained in the General Financial Rules and the instructions issued by MoF from time to time.
5. The scheme will come to an end on 31st March, 2012. Thereafter, the State Governments/UT Administrations/Institutes concerned will take over the responsibility of operation of the Faculty/Centre for Disaster Management. Assistance from the Central Government for these Faculties/Centres beyond 31.03.2012, if any, may be provided only in the form of programme based support in

accordance with a new Scheme to be considered after 5 years.

6. A copy of this letter is being endorsed to the State Governments/UT Administrations/ATIs/training institutes concerned for their information.

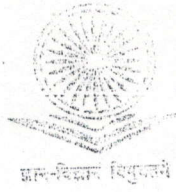

Dear Professor Chaudhuri,

This is in continuation to this office letter No.F.24-9/2008(CU) dated 5th December, 2008 about the intimation of XI Plan allocation of your University. I am grateful to you for the cooperation extended for furnishing the information required by the UGC.

Based on the priorities indicated by you, as well as the availability of funds from Govt. of India, UGC has approved the final XI Plan allocation of **Rs.9225.00 lakh** under General Development Grant. However, the release of grant would be subject to availability of funds received from Govt. of India.

The XI plan allocation under General Development Grant for your University along with the detailed breakup given in the enclosed statements duly signed by the undersigned. This is subject to clarification regarding spill over amount which as per university is Rs.1676.12 lakh whereas as per UGC records it is Rs.3100.00 lakh. A copy of the Visiting Committee Report has already been given to you in the meeting held in the UGC Office.

The UGC has already finalized the guidelines for the schemes to be operated in the XI Plan. These guidelines are posted on the UGC website www.ugc.ac.in. I would request you to browse the UGC website regularly to keep yourself abreast of the latest XI Plan guidelines finalized by the UGC.

The University may follow the procedure for constructions of buildings strictly as prescribed in the UGC guidelines. The Building Committee should be constituted strictly as per UGC guidelines and the constitution of the Committee should be intimated to UGC.

The University may follow strictly the Government of India/UGC's guidelines regarding implementation of the reservation policy [both vertical (for SCs, STs & OBCs) and horizontal (for persons with disability etc.)] in teaching and non-teaching posts.

The teaching posts as approved by the UGC in the existing departments may be filled up in a phased manner as per requirement of the University. The teaching posts for the new proposed departments may be filled up on the basis of intake of students admitted in the University. The requirement of non-teaching staff will be considered separately by the Committee constituted for this purpose and will be communicated to you shortly.

I hope the university must have also initiated the Academic Reforms as already circulated by the UGC vide its D.O.No.F.1-2/2008 (XI Plan) dated 31st January, 2008. It may also be ensured that the university has adopted the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2008.

In the end, I would request you to ensure that the utilization of the grants received by the university shall be submitted to the UGC in time to enable smooth management of funds and to avoid unnecessary audit objections.

- (v) Before the amount is paid, a bond shall be executed by the Institute/Organization in respect of the grant, if necessary under Rules. The organization receiving the grant shall have to give an undertaking that no grant-in-aid has been received from any other authorities of the Central or State Governments and that a grant-in-aid for the same purpose has not been applied for by the organization to any of those authorities.
- (vi) The account of all grantee Institutions or Organization shall be opened, for to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and Internal Audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department whenever the institution or organization is called upon to do so.
- (vii) The organization shall have to give an undertaking that the grant shall be utilized for the purpose, and only for the purpose, for which it is sanctioned. Failure to do so shall render the organization liable to refund to the Government the grant in full with such interest thereon as the Central Government may decide.
- (viii) Separate accounts for the grant will be maintained and any information sought by the Government of India will be furnished within the stipulated time.
- (ix) The assets acquired through government grant except those declared obsolete shall not be disposed of without prior approval of the authority which sanctioned the grant.
- (x) The grant received under this scheme shall not be utilized for meeting the previous liabilities or debt.
- (xi) A Utilization Certificate, certifying that the amount has been utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned duly supported by a statement of audited accounts from a Chartered Accountant or authorized auditor of the University/Institution as the case may be and countersigned by the head of the organization, shall be furnished immediately after the close of current financial year 2008-09 within one year from the date of issue of the sanction. No previous UC is pending in respect of scheme for which this sanction relates.
- (xii) TA/DA should be paid as per Government of India Rules.
- (xiii) The decision of the Secretary to the Government of India in the Ministry of Human Resource Development (Department of Higher Education) on the question whether there has been breach or violation of any of the terms and conditions appended to the grant shall be final and binding on the grantee.
- (xiv) Institution receiving grant should irrespective of the amount involved, be required to maintain subsidiary accounts of the Government grant and furnish to the accounts officer a set of audited statement of accounts. These audited statement of accounts should be furnished after utilization of the grants-in-aid or whenever called for. The accounts of all grantee institutions shall be open for inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit.

- The teaching positions as per the sanctioned strength should be filled first to maintain a continuous and effective ratio of 1 : 1.1 between existing teaching positions and existing non-teaching staff in position.
- The Group 'D' posts like Mali, Peon, Sweeper, Security Guard, Daftary etc will be abolished as and when the post gets vacated due to superannuation, resignation, death etc.

2. The Tezpur University has already signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Dr. Ambedkar Foundation as envisaged in the scheme of setting up of Dr. Ambedkar Chair.

3. Out of 7.00 Lakhs released to the chair an amount of 2.00 lakhs shall be for meeting expenditure at the time of initial establishment of the chair and this amount shall be utilized for procuring the necessary equipments like typewriters, furniture, cupboard, FAX, Computer, books etc. The remaining Rs. 5.00 lakhs is an advance for meeting expenses on working of the chair.

4. The Expenditure will be met from the additional grants released to the foundation in connection with Nationwide Celebration of 125th Birth Anniversary of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar.

5. This sanction is issued with the concurrence of JS & FA vide her Dy No. 13302 dated 05/04/2016 and with the approval the Hon'ble Chairman DAF and HMSJE vide his Dy No. 545 dated 22.04.2016.

6. The Dr. Ambedkar Chair at Tezpur University will submit the audited account and utilization certificate in the prescribed format (GFR-19A) to the Foundation before the release next instalment of Grant-in-aid.

Minorities, Backward Classes and other Weaker Sections of the Society. In pursuance of these objectives, the Chairs will undertake research for understanding and disseminating the ideas of Babasaheb Ambedkar. These objectives shall be achieved not only by conducting research and teaching, but also by organizing Seminars, Symposia, Workshops and other similar academic activities.

4. Staffing of the Chairs

To carry out the above mentioned objectives and to discipline the functions assigned to them each Chair set up in different Universities/Educational Institutions will have the following staff:-

Against each of the above refereed posts persons shall be recruited in accordance with the Statutes, Rules and Regulations followed by the concerned Universities/Educational Institutions in this regard keeping in view the conditions stipulated under the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) entered between Dr. Ambedkar Foundation and the concerned Universities/Institutions. The posts of Professor, Research Officer, Stenographer and Peon will be permanent and hence the persons working against each post will be treated on par with regular staff in the University/ Educational Institution for all purposes.

Further, in respect of service matters, the staff functioning under the Chairs shall be governed by the Rules and Regulations and Statues followed by the University/Institution in this regard. The staff working under the Chairs shall be eligible for all benefits such as HRA, CCA and all other allowances/benefits which are available to the rest of the staff working under such University/Institution.

5. **Appointment of Staff**

Appointment to the posts of Professor and Research Officer shall be made by following the same procedure as followed in respect of regular Professors and the Lecturers in the concerned University/Institution. The Selection Committee shall include a representative from the Dr. Ambedkar Foundation. The persons appointed against the posts of Professor and Research Officer of Dr. Ambedkar Chair shall be treated as regular staff members of the University/Institution. Professors so appointed shall be eligible for all the privileges, which are available to the rest of the Professors such as Membership of the Senate, Syndicate and various Academic and other Bodies/Councils of the University/ Institution.

(a) **Professor**

Only a person adequately qualified in the relevant discipline(s)/subject shall be appointed as the Professor of the Chair. He/she shall be appointed by following the same procedure which is applicable for selection of a full time Professor in the concerned University/Institution. No superannuated person shall be appointed to the Chair. Academic qualifications, experience, age limit etc. to be followed in this regard shall be similar to those which are applicable for selection to the post of a Professor in the concerned University/Institution. The Professor should possess adequate knowledge and working experience on Dr. Ambedkar's thoughts and works and should possess proven commitment to the cause of Social Justice. As far as possible, persons belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Backward Classes or those belonging to other Weaker Sections of the society may be preferred while selecting as Professor and Research Officer under Dr. Ambedkar Chair.

(b) **Research Officer**

A Research Officer in the rank and scale of Lecturer to University shall be recruited and appointed by following the same procedure, which is applicable for recruitment to the post of Lecturer in an Indian University. All the terms and conditions applicable in service matters to Lecturers in the University shall also be applicable to Research Officer. The Research Officer shall function under overall supervision of the Professor of the Chair.

(c) **Stenographer Grade 'C' and Peon**

Stenographer Grade 'C' and Peon shall be selected by following the procedures as laid down under the Rules of the University/Institution for such posts.

6. Monitoring

For regular monitoring and periodic review of the work of the Chairs, the Foundation would set up two Committees, as follows:-

- (i) A Performance Appraisal Committee - for regular monitoring and
- (ii) A Review-cum- Evaluation Committee - for periodic evaluation

Indicative details of the two Committees are as follows:-

(i) The 'Performance Appraisal Committee' will keep a regular watch over various programmes to be conducted by the Chairs on behalf of DAF. It would perform concurrent review of the Chairs with a view to taking timely correctives steps. It would consist of 3 retired Vice-Chancellors or persons of similar academic eminence.

(ii) A 'Review-cum-Evaluation Committee' will be set up to assess the overall functioning of the Chair w.r.t. its objectives over a period of time. It would be set up at intervals of 3-5 years, and will consist of five members including 3 academicians and scholars, nominated by Chairperson, DAF, a nominee of UGC, and a representative of DAF, nominated by the Chairperson

7. Submission of Annual Report, Audited Utilization Certificate and Statement of Accounts

The Chair shall publish Annual Report highlighting the activities undertaken in various fields in terms of the Memorandum of Understanding as well as the Scheme every year. It will also submit Annual Report to the Foundation showing the utilization of the funds released to them. Accounts and financial transactions of the Chairs shall be audited in the same manner as the accounts of University are audited once in a year and a statement showing the detailed audited account shall be submitted to the Foundation as soon as the accounts are audited.

The Universities/ Institutes/Chairs may submit the Utilization certificates issued by a Chartered Accountant, as interim documents, for facilitating early release of the grants to the Chairs. However, the CAG/Local Fund Audit Report (as applicable to them) should be submitted by the University/Institute as and when this Audit is done. The Chair also shall submit the 10 Point Annual Action Plan for the next year to the Foundation before releasing the grant.

The Chair also shall submit the 10 Point Annual Action Plan for the next year to the Foundation before releasing the grant. Topics for the research projects, seminars/ workshops,

lectures, discussions, training programmes etc. may be decided in consultation with the Foundation before the commencement of the next financial year.

8. **Funding the Chairs**

An amount of **Rs. 35.00 lakh** per year would be provided as grant-in-aid to each Chair to carry out activities as enshrined under the Scheme as well as Memorandum of Understanding. The Chair will be financed out of the interest earned from the Corpus Fund created for this purpose in Dr. Ambedkar Foundation. The funds shall be released in advance every year and the Chair/University shall not divert these funds for any purpose other than for running the affairs of the Chair as shown in the annexure to this Scheme. The Chair will come into effect after the Professor is appointed.

To facilitate establishment of the Chairs one time grant of Rs. 2.00 lakh shall be released to each Chair at a the time of initial establishment of each Chair. This grant of Rs. 2.00 lakh shall be utilized for procuring the necessary equipments like typewriters, furniture, cupboard, FAX, Computer, books etc. The broad heads/items under which the annual grant **Rs. 35.00 lakh** shall be spent are shown in Annexure to the Scheme. As far as possible utilization of the funds should be restricted to the limit prescribed under each sub-head unless and otherwise warranted by special circumstances.

9. **Management of the Scheme**

The Scheme of establishment and management of Dr. Ambedkar Chairs shall be administered by Dr. Ambedkar Foundation, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India.

Instructions and guidelines issued from the Foundation from time to time shall be binding and strictly followed in carrying out the affairs of the Chairs.

The Chair will function as an integral unit of the University/Department under which it is set up. For all day-to-day administrative and academic purposes, Professor heading Dr. Ambedkar Chair shall report to the Head/Chairman of the Department/ Centre of the University under which it is established. The University will set up an Advisory Committee consisting three persons in the concerned Department/Centre under the Chairmanship of the Head of the Department/Chairman of Centre to advise the activities of the Chair.

The Scheme will come into force with immediate effect.

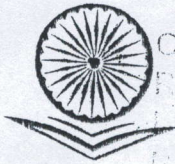

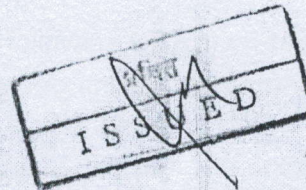



The above approval is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-


